Loss= no. of voters * working hours


Which is giving great loss.So,to avoid this I am proposing new version of voting system.


B.PROPOSED SYSTEM

In this System, voter can go to any nearby booth and can vote by following simple steps. The system at each booth have details of all constituencies. Voter is authenticated by his Aadhar no.(UID) & thumb impression or any finger impression. System will authenticate person by simply cross checking his details as these details are already available with government's UID scheme. Then voter has to select state, constituency, ward and candidate from respective ward. As soon as voter touches the screen for particular candidate that window will disappear displaying message that "your

invaluable vote is get stored". This voting information is get stored with election commission office as well as collector office of respective district in case of 'Panchayati Raj' elections.
