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


- ► To characterize Speech and Language Therapy (SLT) student's:


Methods

World Café in an online event (*Vem beber um café... Vamos falar de Terapia da Fala*) held on the European Day of SLT in 2021 (6th of March of 2021)



- Motivation for choosing SLT programmes and the profession is related to affective factors, influence of significant people and the characteristics of the profession, namely because it covers different levels of intervention and populations.
- Telepractice and the use of new technologies is seen as a positive change and challenge to the future of the profession.
- The need to disseminate the profession to the community was expressed, and in particular, using social networks, information leaflets, open classes, awareness campaigns and actions targeting future professionals (students of middle and secondary schools), caregivers and other professionals such as health and education professionals.
