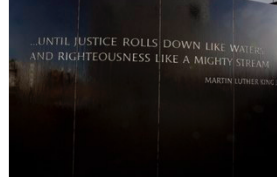

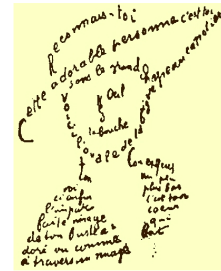
The Poetry of Civil Rights

Compose a poem about an event in the [history of civil rights](#)



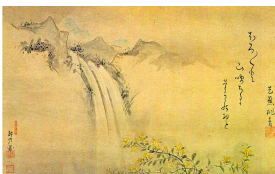
Picture Poetry

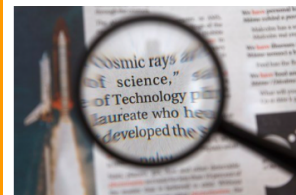

Hide a word or phrase or term you need to learn for school in an [acrostic poem](#) and reveal it one letter at a time, line by line.

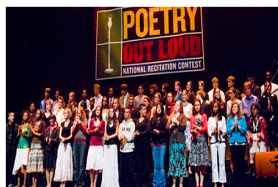


Fibonacci Poetry
