### **Instructional Design**

- Fully asynchronous course.
- Scaffolded skill-development:
  - Knowledge-check;
  - Hands-on practice;
  - Problem-solving;
  - Transfer.
- 80% satisfactory completion threshold.

### **Badging and Micro Credential**

- Individual badges:
  - Are aligned with specific ACRL IL frames;
  - Can be collected in any order.
- The set of 7 badges builds into a credential.
- Credly is integrated into Canvas and will issue the badges and the credential automatically.
