UNH's value to the state only starts with educating its workforce

\$1.5 billion. That's the amount UNH contributes to New Hampshire's economy each year through its expenditures in the state and the cost of educating a highly skilled workforce. It's a big number — the equivalent of spending more than a thousand dollars on each of New Hampshire's 1.3 million residents — but it's only one way of measuring the value the university provides to the Granite State. In October, the state Business and Industry Association awarded UNH its annual New Hampshire Advantage award for contributions that range from NCAA athletics to cultural outreach to its \$850 million impact on the state's skilled workforce.

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
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
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
