TOWN WARRANT

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the inhabitants of the town of Farmington qualified to vote in town affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet in the town hall in said Farmington on Tuesday, the fourteenth day of March next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects:

Article 1. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise to defray the expenses for the ensuing year and make appropriations for the same.

Article 2. To see if the town will vote to appropriate the money received from the state to the current expense fund.

Article 3. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise on a hundred valuation for the repairs and improvement of highways and bridges for the ensuing year.

Article 4. To see if the town will vote to buy a surety bond for its clerk and treasurer.

Article 5. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate to the Clarence L. Perkins Post, No. 60, American Legion, to be used for Memorial day purposes May 30, 1933.

Article 6. To see if the town will vote to pay a discount of three per cent on all property taxes paid on or before August 1st, 1933.

Article 7. To see if the town will authorize the selectmen to administer or dispose of any real estate acquired by the town through tax collector's deeds.

Article 8. To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for parks and playgrounds for the ensuing year, said sum to be intrusted to the Farmington Woman's Club to be expended under the supervision of the selectmen.

Article 9. To see if the town will vote to authorize the selectmen to administer or dispose of the Lydia Randall property acquired by will.

Article 10. To see if the town will adopt the budget system and appoint or elect a budget committee.

Article 11. To see if the town will vote to empower the selectmen to appoint a road agent.

Article 12. To choose one selectman for three years, a town clerk, a town treasurer, a road agent, and all other necessary officers and agents for the ensuing year.

Articles by request or petition appear on the warrant legally posted.

STATEMENT BY THE SELECTMEN

TO THE CITIZENS AND TAXPAYERS
OF FARMINGTON, NEW HAMPSHIRE:

We submit this annual report for the fiscal year ending February 1, 1933, for your consideration, believing it represents a true picture of the conduct of your town's business, clearly detailed and itemized. Your careful scrutiny and criticism is invited.

Emergency in town finances is still apparent. We again recommend expenditures be heavily reduced. The earning power of the taxpayer having been reduced, it is essential the tax burden be made to correspond with the ability to pay. Sound, economical principles should be our guide to accomplish this result.

We recommend the adoption of the budget system. That a committee be appointed to act in conjunction with the selectmen to carefully check each item on which the tax money is raised. This committee, in our opinion, should include one member of the School Board and Precinct. As these two governmental departments spend over fifty per cent of the tax money, a closer relation between the departments working along the lines of economy should produce favorable results. If one department economizes and another does not, the maximum amount of efficiency is not obtained. Economy must be practiced in the school and precinct expenditures to effect any material reduction on the tax rate.

That a road agent be appointed is still a matter which every taxpayer should consider. Combining the

town road work with the work of the state patrolman in charge of trunk line and state aid roads has saved the taxpayers a considerable amount of money. This cannot be denied. The work performed by our present road agent has been done in an efficient and economical manner and has been highly commented on by the state highway department. In all probability the present road agent will have charge of the trunk line and state aid roads the coming year, and we believe the state patrolman should be endorsed as town road agent which will combine the road work under one supervision and eliminate duplication of purpose and waste.

The year just closed has been a trying one for business, individuals and municipalities and we believe the reduction in the town debt of \$9,417.77 under these trying conditions shows an earnest effort in the right direction of all town officials and employes. In closing, we wish to extend our appreciation to this group as well as the many individuals who contributed so much to the success of the administration this year.
