Proof of coach Roning's prowess to gain the respect of those around him came at the conclusion of the 1951 football season, his first as Utah State's head coach, when the sportswriters of the Rocky Mountain area voted him the "Skyline Coach of the Year." He pulled the Aggies out of the cellar with a team that wasn't supposed to have it.

The 40 year old native of Minnesota, of Norwegian parents, was an end on Minnesota's most powerful football teams of '32, '33, '34. Upon graduation with a degree in physical education he went to Anoka high school for a three year stint as a four sport coach. He entered the college coaching ranks in the spring of '39 when he started as director of athletics and three sport coach at Gustavus Adolphus college in the Golden Gopher state.

After service in the navy as a lieutenant commander, he returned to his alma mater and coached the Gopher "M" team in '47. After that time he served as back-field coach and right hand man to coach Bierman.



## About Tonight's Game . . .

Tonight's game is the first Utah Aggie appearance in the state since last season. This is the first time that College of the Pacific has played the Utags in this state and only the second time that the two schools have met in football competition.

The first meeting of the two was in '47 in California with the Tigers winning 35-27 . . .

The Tigers are supposed to be the favorites in tonight's ball game based upon their size in the line and class in the backfield. Competition

against California, Oregon, and Boston University by the Bengals makes them in a faster league perhaps, but Denver nipped them last year down at Stockton 35-33. Looking at the record book one finds that the Aggies bumped Denver 18-7 last year . . .

Pacific's line will average 217—the Aggies 197 . . .

Only one football Aggie is a local boy. That is Junior Bybee from Uintah. There are several Weber Junior College on the Utah State squad, however. Captain Dale Gardner, Lamont Lamb, and Eli Keolanui all played for the Wildcats in their frosh and sophomore years . . .

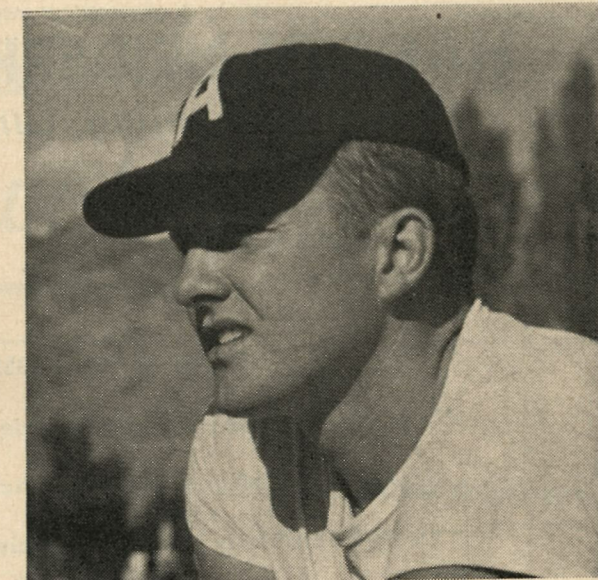

## The Coaching Staff . . .

The driver, the guy who can dish out the work and does produce the linemen is big and broad Cal Stoll, Utah State's line coach. A part of the Roning youthful coaching set-up, he works the tackles and guards plenty and claims his boys are the heroes of the ball club.

Cal, a six year navy veteran, has been out of Minnesota just two years, but enjoyed a successful baptismal season as prep coach at Mound, Minn., where his team won the high school championship in '50, that school's first in 22 years.

Working on his master's now, he also helps with the track squad in the Spring. He is all business at work, but has a great sense of humor and is well liked by the team members. Married, he has two children.



Cal Stoll, Minnesota '50

One of Utah State's finest athletes and most promising coaches, Ralph Maughan, returned to the campus last season as the third new young mentor in Roning's scheme.

Handling both frosh football and basketball, Ralph's team was undefeated during the '51 grid season of four ball games and lost but two tilts of 13 during the hardwood campaign.

The big Cache Valley product lettered in basketball, track, and football in pre-war days and then, after a long stint in the service, he returned as first string center on the Aggie conference championship team in '46. He was thrice named all-conference lineman.

He was a standout in track, rating as one of the nation's best hammer throw competitors. He won conference firsts in the shot, javelin, and hammer three years running.

After a season of pro-ball with the Detroit Lions and a three year college coaching duty at Ricks college, he returned to his alma mater.

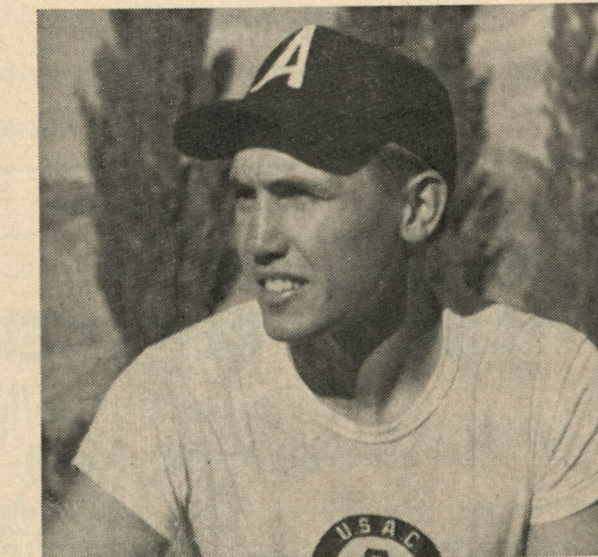


Ralph Maughan, Utah State '48

A former Big Ten ace, Evvy Faunce has plenty of playing experience and know-how to tutor the Aggie backs during the grid campaigns. A hard worker, recently married Ev is the jack-of-all-trades on the coaching staff. He coaches the backs in the Fall, is varsity ski team coach during the Winter months, and is varsity baseball mentor in the Spring.

He was voted the most valuable player on the '48 Minnesota football team and that same season was second best individual ground gainer in the Big Ten. After receiving his degree in engineering-business, Faunce played a season of pro-ball with the Baltimore Colts. Before coming to Utah State he was head football coach at Minot State Teachers, Minot, N.D.

Mrs. Faunce is the former Katherine Campion of Brigham City. The two were married last July.

Sometimes football success seems as simple and as uncomplicated as that. But never to the coach. And seldom to those who know the long hours of training, the teamwork, the practice that goes into play.

And back of the front lines are those other lines that are essential to this success at Utah State.

It's an interesting route as you go back. The coach is praised, and in turn he praises his assistant coaches. All of them praise the varsity. The varsity praises the reserves for their unselfish contribution. Both varsity and reserves praise the

freshmen for their spirit and sacrifice.

### Play Honor With Utah State

Back of the freshmen are the high school coaches, the alumni, the church, the parents who train and encourage boys to play so that they may some day play with honor for the Aggies.

The long run or touch-down pass may be speedier and more colorful, but so are they more unusual, and come only from percentages that attend constant effort.

Every man, woman, and child in America faces a future in which the key to success or failure is in leadership. Everyone therefore has a definite stake in the colleges and universities from which our leaders come. Utah State is your school. Its "team" is open. You can come out for it. Through the Alumni Association you can help develop Utah State so that if the people of America were asked to send a college or university to an academic Rose Bowl, they would select Utah State.

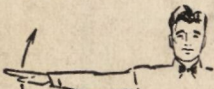
