

UT Tyler Appoints Director of Longview University Center

Karen Lee of Longview has been appointed director of UT Tyler Longview University Center, President Rodney H. Mabry has announced.

"I am pleased that a person of Karen Lee's ability and stature has agreed to help bring UT Tyler's Longview University Center to life," said Mabry. "Karen's excellent record of administrative success, her great people skills, and her conviction that Longview needs greater access to higher education, make her the perfect choice."

Lee will work with UT Tyler administrators and area higher education institutions to develop the Longview University Center's academic course offerings for the fall 2000 semester.

A longtime resident of Longview, Lee served as senior lecturer of accounting at UT Tyler from 1984 to 1994 when she was appointed Deputy Inspector General of the U.S. Small Business Administration in Washington, D.C. At UT Tyler she taught business law, federal income tax, and accounting in the College of Business Administration.

She has returned to Longview after retiring from the position of Acting Inspector General of the Small Business Administration, a position she had held since December 1997.

Lee holds a bachelor of arts degree in political science and a law degree from the University of Minnesota and a graduate certificate in accounting from American University. She is licensed as an attorney in Texas and Minnesota and as a certified public accountant in Texas.

Lee began her extensive federal career in 1964 as an attorney with the Veterans Administration (Department of Veterans Affairs). Other positions held include Deputy Assistant Secretary for Administration, U.S. Department of Transportation; Special Assistant and Staff Attorney, U.S. Department of Justice; and Deputy Director and Management Analyst, U.S. Department of Justice.

Meadows Gallery summer show features mixed-media sculpture


The UT Tyler Meadows Gallery is presenting a summer show featuring the drawings and mixed-media sculptures of Tyler artist Philana Oliphant.

The show, *Passerby*, will be on exhibit through August 27.


Admission is free and open to the public.


