Coronavirus Update—Report Positive Test Results

Dear members of the Sacred Heart University community,

We want to remind everyone that you need to self-report if you test positive for COVID-19.

Students who test positive need to self-report using the <u>Student COVID-19 Self-Report Questionnaire</u>. You need to do this whether or not you are seeking treatment from health services. This will allow us to ensure that notices go out to your professors letting them know you will be missing some classes while you isolate at home, and they may need to accommodate you as you work to keep up with your studies.

Employees who test positive need to notify their supervisors. Depending on how you are feeling and the nature of your work duties, it may be possible for you to work from home during your isolation period. You will work this out with your supervisor. If you find you will need to miss more than five workdays, please contact Sally Schettino in HR to make additional arrangements.
