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
RESEARCH STATEMENT - Printmaking Exchange Portfolio [Creative Portfolio]



Background: Walter Benjamin's 'The Work of Art in the Age of Mechanical Reproduction' (1936) questions the value of originality in art through the eroding distinction made between the original and copy in photography and film as art forms. Concurrently, the accessibility and popularity of producing multiples such as Andy Warhol's photographic silkscreen prints *Marilyn* (1967) transform the ways in which artists and viewers can engage with reproductions as artworks.

Contribution: The *Printmaking Exchange Portfolio* 2022 explores the production of contemporary multiples as a form of artist exchange across the Australian higher education sector. The exchange takes on a novel approach in developing personal collection of cross-university prints that mark a particular time and moment within national university education through the exploration of diverse image-based reproductions.

Significance: The *Printmaking Exchange Portfolio 2022* involves Australian cross-university exchanges curated by renowned printmakers such as Carolyn Mackenzie-Craig from National Art School, Richard Harding from RMIT, Emma Jolley from Curtin University and Rhi Johnson from the University of Southern Queensland. The calibre of these cross-university partnerships, along with eighty-nine participating artists in this exchange is a testimony to the success of this creative portfolio project. The portfolio also features nationally renowned artists such as Jazmina Cininas, Taylor Gollan and Grace Dennis.




