SPEECH MEMORIAL DAY, 1978 BEAVER, OHIO

OVER ONE MILLION AMERICAN MEN AND WOMEN

CONFLICTS FROM THE BATTLE OF BUNKER HILL TO THE BEACHES AT NORMANDY TO THE JUNGLES OF VIETMAN. AND MANY MORE AMERICANS HAVE DIED AND NEVER BEEN ACCOUNTED FOR. IN OUR OVER TWO HUNDRED YEARS OF EXISTENCE AS A NATION WE HAVE HAD TO FIGHT TO SURVIVE. WE COULD NOT TAKE OUR FREEDOM FOR GRANTED. WE COULD NOT REST CARELESSLY. WE HAD TO SACRIFICE AND WORK -AND, YES, AT TIMES DIE.

THE COST TO BE FREE IS VERY HIGH. PRESIDENT HARRY TRUMAN ONCE

TEARS AND SORROW FOR THOSE WHO WERE NEVER ABLE TO RETURN HOME

-HOME TO A MOTHER

-HOME TO A FATHER

-HOME TO A SPOUSE AND FAMILY

-HOME TO A JOB OR AN EDUCATION

-HOME TO OPPORTUNITY AND PROSPERITY

-AND HOME TO BE FREE.

LET'S NEVER FORGET THAT OUR FREEDOM IS WORTH FIGHTING FOR,

IT IS WORTH DYING FOR.

UNFORTUNATELY FREEDOM IS NOT LIKE A FAMILY HEIRLOOM THAT IS

EASILY PASSED ON FROM GENERATION TO GENERATION. MAYBE SOMEDAY

IT WILL BE LIKE THAT, BUT TODAY WE STILL HAVE TO BE PREPARED TO

HOPEFULLY, THE FUTURE WILL NOT RESULT IN BATTLEGROUNDS FOR

US LIKE ANGOLA -OR CHINA.

TODAY, ALL ACROSS OHIO, AND ACROSS THE UNITED STATES, THERE

ARE PARADES, SPEECHES, AND CEREMONIES IN COMMEMORATION OF OUR WAR

DEAD. THIS PAGENTRY IS MEANINGLESS UNLESS WE REFLECT UPON THE TRUE

VALUE OF OUR FREEDOM. WE MUST REMEMBER THAT FREEDOM HAS A HIGH

COST -BOTH TO WIN IT AND TO RETAIN IT.

WE MUST BE PREPARED TO DEFEND OUR FREEDOM IF IT IS NECESSARY

TO DO SO AGAIN. / WE MUST NEVER FORGET THAT OVER A MILLION AMERICANS

DIED TO PROTECT THIS NATION, ITS GOVERNMENT, AND ITS WAY OF LIFE.

TAKE A FEW MOMENTS. LOOK AROUND AT WHAT IS HERE.

THIS WALLEY AND ITS HOLLOWS ARE HOME FOR FREE MEN AND WOMEN.

THE STEAM RISING FROM THE A-PLANT, OFF TO THE WEST AND SOUTH,

IS A SIGN OF STRENGTH

THE PERSON STANDING NEXT TO YOU -SAY HELLO, SHAKE HIS HAND,

SAY I'M GLAD TO BE FREE.

TRUTH OF THE INALIENABLE SOVEREIGNITY OF PEOPLE."

PROCLAIMED ON THIS DAY THE PRECIOUS RIGHTS PROCLAIMED ON THIS DAY THE PRECIOUS RIGHTS SEALED IN BLOOD BY PAST GENERATIONS IN WARS AGAINST THOSE WHO WOULD THREATEN THESE RIGHTS, REPRESENT TO THE WORLD TODAY THE LOFTY AND UNCOMPARED IDEALS WHICH ALL AMERICANS AND THOSE IN THE WORLD WHO LOVE FREEDOM MUST DEFEND AND PROTECT AGAINST ANY WHO WOULD SEEK TO DENY THESE TRUTHS.

IT IS IMPORTANT THAT WE HERE, TODAY, IN ON THIS MEMORIAL INDEPENDENCE DAY, LOOK INTO OUR HEARTS AND OUR MINDS AND WEIGH THE TREMENDOUS ADVANTAGES WE HAVE IN THIS COUNTRY. IT IS IMPORTANT THAT WE WEIGH AND REFLECT UPON THE PRECIOUS BUT FRAGILE LIBERTIES OF FREE GOVERN-MENT. THIS NATION HAS, ON NUMEROUS OCCASIONS, DISPLAYED ITS INCOMPANY COURAGE TO PROTECT THESE LIBERTIES. IT IS FITTING, THEN, THAT WE PAUSE TODAY TO REDEDICATE OURSELVES TO THOSE IDEALS FOR WHICH SO MANY HAVE DIED THAT OTHERS MIGHT REMAIN UNFETTERED.

PRAY GOD, THAT WE SHALL ALWAYS KEEP THE FAITH WITH THOSE BRAVE AMERICANS WHO, IN SACRIFICING THEIR LIVES, HAVE HELPED OUR COUNTRY THROUGHOUT THE PAGES OF HISTORY TO KEEP FOREVER BURNING THE ETERNAL TORCH OF FREEDOM.

PRAY THAT THROUGH DIVINE LOVE AND AN ABIDING FAITH IN ALMIGHTY GOD THAT OUR NATION WILL REMAIN UNITED AND FREE -- AND THAT THE STAR SPANGLED BANNER AS THE SYMBOL OF THE EXPRESSED IN THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE, SHALL CONTINUE TO WAVE IN TRIUMPH OVER THE LAND OF THE FREE AND THE BRAVE -- AS IT HAD SO GLORIOUSLY WAVED AT GETTYSBURG, OMAHA BEACH, GUADACANAL.

IT IS APPROPRIATE THEN THAT WE GATHER TODAY TO RENEW THE SPIRIT OF OUR FOREFATHERS AND BE MADE AWARE OF OUR GREAT HERITAGE, ON THIS DAY OF CELEBRATION AND REJOICING, LEF US FEEL SOMETHING OF GRATITUDE WITH OUR AS WE WITNESS THE FIREWORKS BURSTING IN AIR, IT $\angle ET$ US GIVE THOUGHT TO OUR DUTY AS A CITIZEN OF THIS GREAT STATE AND NATION -- AS WE THRILL TO THE SOUNDS AND COLORS OF THE BELLS RUNG IN THE CHURCHES AND THE STRIKING DISPLAY OF THE NOISE, AND SMOKE OF THE ROCKETS, LET US RENEW AND STRENGTHEN OUR FAITH IN THOSE PRINICIPLES WHICH ARE

FOUND IN THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE. OTHER NATIONS MAY RISE AND CRUMBLE -- NEW TYRANTS MAY ARISE TO THREATEN THE PEACE OF THE WORLD --YET SO LONG AS MEN EXIST WHO REVERE THE PRICIPLES UPON WHICH THIS NATION WAS FOUNDED..."LIFE, LIBERTY, AND THE PURSUIT OF HAPPINESS", WE SHALL REMAIN STRONG. DESTINED TO GREATNESS AND RENOWN THE FLAG OF THIS REPUBLIC SHALL WAVE ON ITS PRIDE AND GLORY.

IN CLOSING, I WOULD LIKE TO READ TO YOU SEVERAL VERSES FROM ONE OF MY FAVORITE POEMS, THE AUTHOR IS UNKNOWN, BUT HIS WORDS AND FEELINGS BELONG TO EACH OF US AND TO ALL AMERICANS VET UNBORN. THESE THRILLING LINES DESCRIBE VIVIDLY THE GIVING OF THE SIGNAL WHICH TOLLED THE NEWS THAT THE DECALRATION OF INDEPENDENCE HAD BEEN

SIGNED.
