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Today I've spent the morning mountain biking and connecting with old friends before checking the real estate market. After working I had a BBQ with friends and family.



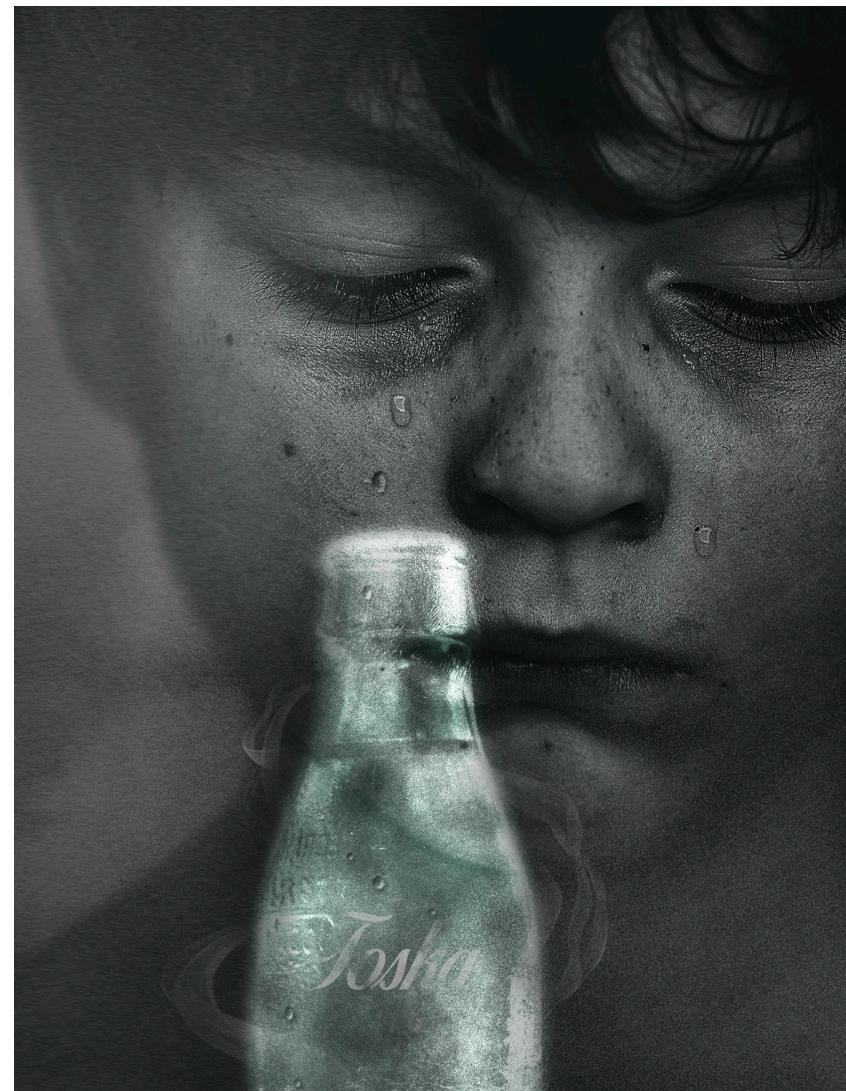
