

OBITUARY

ALBERT STREM, 92, the Police Department's oldest and highest-ranking auxiliary police officer, died Monday.

He will be buried today with full police honors. Strem, who was still on the active duty roster, spent 48 years as a volunteer with the department, rising to the rank of one-star deputy chief.

Funeral services will be at 12:30 p.m. today at Louis Hirsch & Sons Funeral Home, E. 167th St. and Jerome Ave., the Bronx, with burial at Washington Cemetery in Deans, N.J. Strem, who lived in Co-op City in the Bronx, is survived by a brother, Alex, of Manhattan.
