Cybersecurity Capacity Maturity Model in South American Countries – Current Tendencies

The Observatory of Cybersecurity in Latin America and the Caribbean monitors and compares the region's countries based on their cybersecurity capacities. The Observatory operates within the framework of the Organization of American States and the Inter-American Development Bank and developed the cybersecurity maturity model (CMM) based on five dimensions including policy and strategy, culture and society, education, legal frameworks and technologies. The paper aims to provide a comparative analysis based on a mixed approach methodology taking into account both quantitative and qualitative factors determining the current cybersecurity capacities at the national level. The comparison focuses on Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia and Uruguay and targets to overview the latest developments of the region in the field including some of the future potentials.
