



Wild animals housed at the IBAMA triage center in Southern Brazil, 2005–2021: a glimpse into the endless conflicts between man and other animals

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ABSTRACT

Spurred on by the illegal billion-dollar revenue, the capture and trade of wild fauna remain the leading illegal activities in Brazil, and elsewhere. We present and discuss insights into the wild animals housed at the Wild Animal Triage Center in Southern Brazil. Recorded data from 2005 to 2021 were used. A total of 36,950 animals were sheltered in that period, and most of them were common passerines (24,182) such as the Saffron Finch, and Red-crested Cardinal, among many others confiscated after inspections or reports. Passerines have long been the top trafficked species in Brazil and abroad, where birdkeeping has strong cultural and economic values. The totals per class were 29,784 birds (80.6%), 2,584 (7.0%) insects, 2,237 (6.1%) reptiles, and 2,170 (5.9%) mammals. Since they were mostly surrendered by the population rather than seized, most mammals, insects, and reptiles were probably unwanted guests in human spaces, tendency that illustrates the human difficulty in coexisting with wildlife. A total of 3,085 animals exhibited some threat or risk of extinction, which, as a general rule, grants them conservation priority. However, regardless of class, most animals (31,142) in this study were rated as least concern on the red lists, a trend in wildlife trafficking linked to the category criteria of being widely distributed species with abundant populations, and often, in close contact with human neighbors. Maintaining an abundance of common and nonthreatened species can be justified by the greater extent of their ecosystem services, from a local to global scale. Our results further highlight the urgent need to change our ways of interacting with wildlife, outstandingly the irresponsible ownership of animals.

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SIGNIFICANCE STATEMENT

This is an analytical study on wild animal dataset from IBAMA's CETAS in Rio Grande do Sul State – period from 2005 until 2021. We highlight the numbers per species and their main reasons for entry in the CETAS. Understanding the magnitude of these figures is essential for both public awareness and the planning of wildlife management and conservation.

INTRODUCTION

The illegal wildlife trade remains a worldwide criminal activity, mostly linked to vulnerable rural communities (Destro *et al.* 2019a) where it is a potential source of income. Estimates have placed the annual retail value of wildlife trafficking between US \$5 billion and \$23 billion (May 2017). Some of the consequences of illegal wildlife trafficking include endangering species, ecological costs, animal cruelty, threats to other species, biosecurity threats, violence, and depleting natural resources (UNODOC 2019). The potential spread of zoonotic diseases through the commercial trade of wild animals poses a great risk to public health and the economy, as quantified by the COVID-19 losses (Haider *et al.* 2020; Xiao *et al.* 2020). Corruption and weak governance fuel the activity and further weaken the safety of communities living alongside wilderness areas (Rossi 2018; WCS 2019).

While dozens of thousands of wild animals are confiscated annually in Brazil (RENCTAS 2001; Gama and Sassi 2008; Pagano *et al.* 2009; Alves *et al.* 2013; IBAMA 2016; SAVE Brasil 2017), these registered cases are probably a small fraction of the real magnitude. These findings also highlight the urgent responsibility of properly handling confiscated animals. In Brazil, although numerous animal species are coveted for different purposes, birds are by far the most illegally traded to supply the bird-singing contests, the bird-fight competitions, and the pet market (Ferreira and Glock 2006; Gama and Sassi 2008; Pagano *et al.* 2009; Alves *et al.* 2013; Charity and Ferreira 2020; Santos *et al.* 2021). The main Brazilian sources of illegal wild birds are well-preserved environments close to protected areas in North, Northeast, and Midwest regions (Destro *et al.* 2019a). Its main destinations have been the Southeast region and the State of Rio Grande do Sul, the southernmost traffic flow route in Brazil, including for international smuggling (RENCTAS 2001).

Human-wildlife conflicts occur when the needs and behaviors of each negatively impact the other. While there can be great local variation, common conflict causes include human population expansion, climate change, land use change, and the associated degradation, fragmentation and loss of habitats (Mekonen 2020; Mukeka *et al.* 2019; Distefano 2005), or even intolerance toward wildlife (Mendonça *et al.* 2011;

Jordan *et al.* 2020). While environmental education to promote a better knowledge of wildlife might be the most powerful tool to implement peaceful human-wildlife coexistence (Karimullah *et al.* 2022; Mekonen 2020; Mendonça *et al.* 2011), discouraging habitat conversion and encourage regulating effective and safe management practices may be key points for minimizing conflicts in agricultural systems (Mukeka *et al.* 2019; Distefano 2005).

In Brazil, the Wild Animal Triage Centers (Centros de Triagem de Animais Silvestres – CETAS) comprise legal units that receive, identify, evaluate, recover, rehabilitate, and place wild animals. Therefore, even though there is limited conservation evidence on the subject (Destro *et al.* 2019b), alternatives for the return of confiscated animals to natural environments may have a strategic impact on the current global scenario of a changing environment and wildlife crime. Obviously, these processes entail considerable resources and must be accomplished according to conservation guidelines (IUCN 2000; 2019). This report presents the wild animal statistics at the regional CETAS over a 17-year period and discusses some of the associated social, cultural, and environmental issues. This information is essential for establishing both animal management and conflict-tackling plans.

MATERIAL AND METHODS

Data collected in the period 2005-2021 were retrieved from files stored at CETAS. This wildlife unit belongs to the Regional Superintendence of the Brazilian environmental agency IBAMA (Instituto Brasileiro do Meio Ambiente e dos Recursos Naturais Renováveis), located in Rio Grande do Sul (CETAS/IBAMA/RS). We analyzed the class, order, scientific nomenclature, common name, and total numbers of specimens per species, the conservation status, sex, time in captivity, the year of entry, and the reason for entry. These reasons included apprehension from trafficking (confiscated during enforced inspection), and surrender (whether forwarded from public agencies or voluntarily surrendered by owners or guardians). The collected data were organized in Microsoft Excel® 2017 worksheets and a descriptive statistical analysis was performed using Minitab Statistical Software (Release 20, Minitab Inc., USA). The species identification followed the descriptions pre-

sented previously (Costa and Bérnulis 2014; Del Hoyo and Collar 2014; Piacentini et al. 2015; Costa and Bérnulis 2018; Burgin et al. 2020; Jacobs and Fenalti 2020; Bánki et al. 2022). Records with no specific data about the species (39) were excluded. The IUCN Red List of Threatened Species (IUCN 2022) was used to classify conservation status, and species that were not found there were classified using the ICMBIO list (2018).

RESULTS




Figure 1. Distribution of most frequent classes, orders, species, and operations of animals housed at the CETAS/IBAMA/RS, 2005–2021.




Figure 2. Variation in the number of animals housed at the CETAS/IBAMA/RS, 2005–2021 over time.

The 36,950 animals sheltered at the CETAS/IBAMA/RS, from 2005–2021, are presented in Supplementary Table 1. Around 80.6% of the animals belonged to the class Aves, followed by the classes Insecta (7.0%), Reptilia (6.1%), and Mammalia (5.9%). The classes Actinopterygii, Arachnida, Clitellata, and Chondrichthyes corresponded to 0.4%, when summed. Figure 1 shows the totals per class, the most frequent orders and species in the classes, and the most frequent operation per class/order. Entries of birds, reptiles, and mammals occurred in all years considered in this study, and their numbers increased considerably over time, i.e., around 634%, 525%, and 1,233%, respectively (Figure 2). Most animals were apprehended (29,268 – 79.2%) through acts of inspections or reports, and 26,789 of which were birds. Among them, the most trafficked species were passerines (25,404 – 68.8%) such as the Saffron Finch (*Sicalis flaveola* – 4,670), Red-crested Cardinal (*Paroaria coronata* – 3,657), Green-winged Saltator (*Saltator similis* – 3,270), and Ultramarine Grosbeak (*Cyanoloxia brissonii* – 2,801). Most mammals (1,856), insects (1,484), and reptiles (1,331) were surrendered. Other top positions were occupied by the Giant Silkworm Moth Caterpillar (*Lonomia obliqua* – 1,417) (for insects), the White-eared Opossum (*Didelphis albiventris* – 980) (for mammals), and the Black-bellied Slider (*Trachemys dorbigni* – 1,307) (for reptiles). Among the 3,085 (8.3% – 83 species) animals that exhibited some threat, the passerines Yellow Cardinal (*Gubernatrix cristata* – 187), and Great-billed Seed-finches (*Sporophila maximiliani* – 163) were those most at a risk of extinction, both categorized as endangered (Additional Files 2). A total of 336 confiscated animal carcasses, mostly birds and mammals, characterized the local illegal bushmeat trade. Data concerning the sex and time in captivity was available for 3,680 (~10%) and 11,405 (30%) animals, respectively. Among the male records (3,427), a total of 3,172 were passerines presenting evident sexual dimorphism. Most of the 253 identified females were mammals. Among animals with recorded time in captivity, 5,975 passerines occupied the top position out of 8,568 animals that were kept for weeks to months,

before apprehension. Psittacine, especially *Amazona aestiva* were among those animals kept longer (years) in captivity (Additional Files 2).

DISCUSSION

The uncontrolled exploitation of natural resources by mankind has led to unprecedented losses in biodiversity, a worsening climate crisis, and poorer global health (UNODOC 2019). The underlying causes of threats to biodiversity are associated with growing population, weak governance, limited employment opportunities, poverty, lack of awareness, and insecure land tenure, to mention a few (Rossi 2018; Destro et al. 2019). Although there may be some place-to-place variations, the demand for wildlife is driven by reasons which can be grossly grouped into four main categories i.e., collectibles, pets, traditional medicine/religion, and food (Krishnasamy and Zavagli 2020). Stimulated by the illegal billion-dollar revenue, the worldwide poaching of wildlife for illegal trade remains a top threat to its survival across the Americas, Asia, and Africa (ADB 2016; Parry-Jones and Allan 2021). Included in the #1 class in our study (birds), the #1 apprehended order (Passeriformes) (Figure 1) reflects a traditional tendency in the targeting and trafficking of passerines in Brazil (Pagano et al. 2009; Alves et al. 2013; SAVE Brasil 2017) and elsewhere (Nash 1993; Chng et al. 2016; Eaton et al. 2017). However, we suggest that the higher numbers in the next most frequent classes from this study were most likely unwanted neighbors or co-inhabitants in human spaces, since they were largely surrendered rather than confiscated (Figure 1). Apparently, our numbers are far exceeded by those recorded in the Asian global hub for illegal wildlife trade and trafficking (Krishnasamy and Zavagli 2020; Parry-Jones and Allan 2021). For example, we counted 25,404 passerines that had been (mainly) confiscated over 17 years, whereas over 45,000 songbirds were seized in one year in Southeast Asia (Krishnasamy and Zavagli 2020). Although this discrepancy might hypothetically be attributed to more efficient inspections, there are also hurdles in that region where opportunistic and highly organized buyers and sellers may trade anything online from ivory to live animals such as Tiger (*Panthera tigris*), and Sun Bears (*Helarctos malayanus*) (Krishnasamy and Zavagli 2020).

Although threatened species were also identified in our research (Additional Files 2), the most prevalent species were common and widely found ones (Additional Files 1), as other authors have reported (Pagano et al. 2009; Alves et al. 2013; SAVE Brasil 2017). However, as there have been no recent and comprehensive population estimates, some of the least-concern species currently on the red lists (ICM-

BIO 2018; IUCN 2022), may in fact be in decline due to uncontrolled trapping and the high demand for the wild animal trade (Mittermeier et al. 2014; Chiok et al. 2019; Chng et al. 2021). Small populations tend to lose genetic diversity more quickly than large ones due to changes in relative allele frequency (Nei and Tajima 1981) and therefore, are vulnerable to local extinctions, whose rates are most likely to be higher than the regional extinction rates (Yan et al. 2022). Given that birds are crucial for balanced ecosystems and other ecological services (Whelan et al. 2015; Tchoumbou et al. 2020) and that songbirds have composed the largest portion of apprehensions in Brazil and abroad, we must highlight the need to develop strategies and management practices for proper allo-

cation (IUCN 2000; 2019; Cruz et al. 2021). Among the 25,404 passerines, once again (RENTAS 2001; Pagano et al. 2009; SAVE Brasil 2017), the Saffron Finch (Figure 1), a widely distributed passerine even in urban parks and backyards around the country (eBird 2022), was one of the most numerous apprehended species. The fact that the saffron finch fights as cocks do has been a further cause for its demand. As in cockfighting, highly territorial birds are stimulated and put to combat into a ring, where they fight until severe injury or death (Charity and Ferreira 2020). Fortunately, the saffron finch is a strong and resilient bird even under trafficking conditions which, together with its low nutritional and environmental needs, make it an inexpensive species to rehabilitate

(data not shown). Both the Saffron Finch and the second most numerous passerine species, the Red-crested Cardinal, usually form large winter flocks (Jacobs and Fenalti 2020; eBird 2022). This behavior may partially explain the high numbers of apprehensions since their flocks can be systematically attracted to places baited with cereals and seeds, over days to weeks, and trapped with mist nets (Bub 1991) after the birds have gotten used to the extra meals. The increase in distribution ranges and populations of such open-area species, associated with deforestation (Morante-Filho et al. 2015; Tchoumbou et al. 2020) may also contribute to this tendency. These birds are granivores, and therefore they benefit from grazing areas. Comparatively, resident forest species such as the Green-winged Saltator are easily captured and at greater risk of population decline (BIRDLIFE 2022a; Cruz et al. 2022).

Only a fraction of our records included information about sex and time of captivity (Additional Files 1). Among the identified males (3,427), a total of 3,172 were passersines presenting evident sexual dimorphism. However, this figure may be an underestimate since most young males are visually indistinguishable from females. This illustrates a preferred demand in the bird trade because males are usually colorful and sing better, which increases their value (Alves et al. 2013). Most of these songbird species are territorial, a condition that facilitates the capture of males (Cruz et al. 2022). In this sense, the lack of males caused by illegal trapping has been linked to low reproductive success in free-living populations of the endangered Yellow Cardinal (Segura et al. 2019). This condition is likely to affect other species over

time. Birds with evident wild behavior (fear and slapping cage bars when humans approach) were kept for the shortest periods in captivity (days), but most passersines (among those with recorded time in captivity) were kept for weeks to months in captivity. This may again be linked to higher associated values, since domesticated birds sing more than recently captured ones (Gama and Sassi 2008). Except for the number one position held by the Black-bellied Slider, the next positions among threatened species in our study were birds and included Yellow Cardinal, Red-spectacled Amazon, and Great-billed Seed-finch (Supplementary Table 2). Confiscated specimens should be immediately treated with priority conservation actions (ICMBIO 2013). Psittacine made up the second most numerous bird order at the CETAS, and the Monk Parakeet (*Myiopsitta monachus* – 716) and the Turquoise-fronted Amazon (*A. aestiva* – 536) were the most common species. These findings are consistent with other reports (RENTAS 2001; Pagano et al. 2009; SAVE Brasil 2017). The Island Canary (*Serinus canaria* – 596), and Lovebirds (*Agapornis* sp. – 258) were the most common species among the 2,326 exotic animals at the CETAS. The Island Canary is considered a domestic bird, and therefore exempt from control (IBAMA 2019). These passersines were confiscated due to mistreatment, or lack of environmental authorization, a situation even more common in Brazil.

Among insects, our second highest class, the surrendered Giant Silkworm Moth Caterpillar held the first position, probably due to fear associated with its ability to envenomate. The larvae from these South American Lepidoptera have been linked to hemor-

rhagic syndromes in humans, after direct contact with the caterpillars' setae. Clinical manifestations of the envenomation may vary from altered coagulation parameters in patients with subcutaneous lesions to systemic hemorrhage and acute kidney injury (Berger et al 2013). Other seized insects were the Coleoptera *Zophobas morio*, which larvae are used as live food for other animals. Next in that class were apprehended pet tarantulas and voluntarily surrendered *Phoneutria* sp. venomous spiders.

The popular and small offspring (with carapaces 3-4 cm in diameter) of the Black-bellied Slider, the most numerous reptile species in our study (Figure 1), have been highly demanded in the pet trade (Vogt et al. 2015). However, it is suggested that many uninformed owners stop wanting them when they grow up and reach juvenile and adult sizes. These owners usually abandon them at lakes and weirs in urban parks, or other public spaces, where wildlife managers recapture and deliver them to the CETAS. This species is categorized as near threatened (ICMBIO 2018) and was the most numerous among those exhibiting some threat at the CETAS. There are still few Brazilian studies on responsible animal guardianship, which includes taking lifelong care of the physical, psychological, and environmental health of the animal, in addition to ensuring its well-being (Domingues et al. 2015). According to the contemporary Brazilian doctrine of Animal Law, responsible custody seeks to preserve animal health and prevent cruelty, abandonment and overpopulation between humans and non-humans, in an urban environment (Santana and Oliveira, 2020). Based on both points of view, lifelong primary care was violated for these chelonians. Prior knowledge of the basic biology of the animals is essential to minimize these abandonments. Comparably, Asian studies have shown that chelonians are the most traded (Nijman 2010) and trafficked species (Chng 2014; Badola and Gautam 2022), many of which are categorized as threatened on the IUCN Red List (2022) and listed in the Appendix I trade prohibition from the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES). Smuggling of *Podocnemis* sp. river turtles and their eggs is probably the largest wildlife trade issue in the Brazilian Amazon (Charity and Ferreira 2020). This tendency was not observed in our study, in which most of the 107 tortoises (*Chelonoidis* spp.) were also surrendered at the CETAS, in situations comparable to those of the Black-bellied Slider. Squamata composed the #2 most numerous reptilian order, with the majority being surrendered *Bothrops* sp. poisonous snakes.

The White-eared Opossum was the most numerous mammal, and they were almost exclusively surrendered. Except for the rats (*Rattus* spp.), this mam-

mal is probably the next on the list of free-ranging mammals who live in closest contact with humans in most local areas of urban-rural transition. This position probably illustrates the human difficulty in sharing spaces and coexisting with wildlife (Mekonen 2020; Gross et al. 2021). The White-eared Opossums were also the animals kept for the shortest time in captivity before surrender (425 opossums out of 1,072 animals kept for hours), again possibly showing the degree of human desire to get rid of them. Another prominent mammal group in this study included 267 Samba Deer (*Rusa unicolor*) that were kept for years in a safari park before being euthanized as a control measure during a bovine tuberculosis outbreak (Lima et al. 2021). This South Asian cervid is rated as vulnerable on the IUCN Red List (2022) due to hunting, and logging, among many other human threats. The next most numerous mammal order was Primates (275), especially the Black-horned Capuchin (*Sapajus nigritus*) and the Southern Brown Howler Monkey (*Alouatta guariba clamitans*). The larger portion of these animals had been surrendered at the CETAS due to conflicts described by other authors (Karimullah et al. 2022). Similarly, almost all of the 222 carnivores were surrendered at the CETAS – an unlikely destination for these predators – probably in retaliation for depredations against domestic animals (Charity and Ferreira 2020). Although mammals were not among the most frequent animals in our study (Figure 1), they were among those that showed the highest increases in recent years (Figure 2).

The hunting and selling of wild animals as bushmeat are an important source of food, and have social value in many parts of the globe. Wild meat consumption may be a status symbol that connects some peoples to their ancestral cultures. However, the significant risks to human health involved (van Vliet et al. 2017; Haider et al. 2020; UNODOC 2019; Xiao et al. 2020) justify changing these interactions between humans and wildlife (Campbell et al. 2021). Pangolins, Great Apes, African Civets, and certain species of Antelope are just some of the protected species found for sale by bushmeat vendors across Africa. This demand can lead to the overexploitation of already threatened species (Mbun and Nguemwo 2021). In Brazil, subsistence hunting is allowed by law; however, the trade of bushmeat is illegal. In street markets across the Amazon, tons of illegal wild meat are sold both nationally and across local borders. Species such as the Capybara (*Hydrochoerus hydrochaeris*), South American Tapir (*Tapirus terrestris*), and Lowland Paca (*Cuniculus paca*), among many others are widely poached and sold (Redford 1992; Charity and Ferreira 2020). Cultural attitudes, and taste have been stronger factors for bushmeat consumption and preference than a real need for protein supplementation from the wild

(Morsello et al. 2015; Barboza et al. 2016). In our study, a total of 336 confiscated animal carcasses, consisting mostly of birds such as Eared and Picazuro Doves, but also Tinamous, and mammals like Capybara, Agouti, Coypu, and Deer, illustrate the local preferences for wild meat. Among these mammals were also the vulnerable Brazilian Dwarf Brocket Deer *Mazama nana*, and the Gray Brocket Deer. There is also a high demand for Amazonian fish, for ornamental and food purposes (Charity and Ferreira 2020). In our assessment, only 36 fish were confiscated, mostly the ornamental exotic *Betta splendens*. Most of the wild animals housed at the CETAS were cautiously reintegrated into natural environments through rehabilitation/release programs, but some were sent to authorized breeders and keepers. Some of these results will be disclosed in due course.

Global wildlife trafficking is projected to increase if it is not addressed more holistically by governments, conservation agencies and other partner sectors (Agu and Gore 2020). The survival of global conservation flagship species such Elephants, Rhinos, Tigers, and Pangolins may be greatly compromised (Krishnasamy and Zavagli 2020), as well as the survival of top endangered Brazilian species like the Harpy Eagle (*Harpia harpyja*), Hyacinth Macaw (*Anodorhynchus hyacinthinus*), and Jaguar (*Panthera onca*) (ICMBIO 2018), among many others. In our study, nine *A. hyacinthinus*, and three *H. harpyja* were counted, and both are categorized as vulnerable (Supplementary Table 2). Among those most at a risk of extinction, Yellow Cardinal and Great-billed Seed-finch (both categorized as endangered) were the most numerous at the CETAS. However, the overwhelming majority of the Brazilian confiscations include common songbird species that overwhelm the facilities and teams constituted to receive them. In Brazil (Gama and Sassi 2008; Alves et al. 2013; Charity and Ferreira 2020) and elsewhere (Nash 1993; Nijman 2010; Chng et al. 2016; Eaton et al. 2017; Krishnasamy and Zavagli 2020), birdkeeping – be it for pets, bird-song competitions, or bird fights – is a powerful driver of both the legal and illegal trades. Just like captive breeding has been established as a conservation tool for endangered species (Cristinacce et al. 2009; Collar et al. 2012; Walters et al. 2010), authorized commercial captive breeding could ideally offer an alternative to illegally caught wild birds. Although there are ethical considerations that must be followed to guarantee the reasonable welfare and proper management of these animals in captivity, the assumption that every captive-born bird could prevent the loss of 10 illegally-caught wild conspecifics (Redford 1992; RENCTAS 2001) is indisputable from a conservation perspective. However, the fraudulent practices for laundering wild-caught birds in Brazil and elsewhere (Gama

and Sassi 2008; Janssen and Blanken 2016; Janssen and Chng 2017) hinder society's acceptance and seriously impede sector development. Organized wildlife trading and the expansion of online platforms have been increasing challenges for enforcement and conservation agencies (Harrison et al. 2016; Rossi 2018; Stoner et al. 2017; Braga Júnior and Lima 2021). On the other hand, ethical and responsible breeders do exist, but the commercial breeding of wild animals in Brazil suffers from a historically problematic regulatory process. After decades of exporting South American bird species to supply the pet trade, their reproductive capacity has been appropriated by bird breeders from other continents (Ortiz-von Hale 2018), to the point that some national efforts to reintroduce endangered species are dependent on foreign breeders (BIRDLIFE 2022b). This multibillion-dollar business has left the countries of origin of these species with the difficult task of preventing illegal domestic and international trade, a problem that also affects many exported species of amphibians, reptiles and ornamental freshwater fish (Ortiz-von Hale 2018). According to Conama Resolution 394/074, the list of wild animal species that could be bred and traded should have been published by 2008. The lack of definition of this list has discouraged legal establishments, creating a gap that encourages illegal trade, due to the lack of regularization of the use of this natural resource (RENCTAS 2016).

CONCLUSION

The dimensions of wildlife trafficking highlight socio-economic issues and, although education is key, sustained political will, effective laws, long-term monitoring, and enforcement will pave the way for solutions (ADB 2016; Charity and Ferreira 2020; Mbun and Nguemwo 2021). Therefore, the mitigation of the wildlife crisis requires complex and time-dependent measures, and time is limited for most threatened species, for which zoos and aquariums are an essential part of the recovery programs (Redford et al. 2012). Although most conservation effort is not directed at species nonthreatened with extinction, (IUCN 2022), which are the majority at the CETAS and similar initiatives worldwide (Lee et al. 2016; Chng et al. 2016; Chiok et al. 2019), the impacts of the abundance loss of these common species echoes as a growing global conservation concern (Winfrey et al. 2015; Baker et al. 2019; Gardner et al. 2019). Moreover, there is evidence that common species may also be susceptible to population decline (Chiok et al. 2019; Rosenberg et al. 2019), and there are relevant animal welfare challenges to consider. In this sense, projects for the proper reintegration of confiscated animals into natural environments as well as new perspectives on suit-

able environments for their placement have become priorities due to the number of animals seized annually and the rampant deforestation, respectively. Finally, once again, the supremacy of protected areas stands out, as immediate wildlife refuges across the globe. Whether they are called Federal Conservation Units, National Parks, or any other name, these areas encompass the conservation of entire ecosystems, where the balance depends on both threatened and nonthreatened species. In addition to preserving primordial conservation measures, these protected areas can be expanded over time, and their guardians multiplied, equipped, and valued. However, poverty will always drive communities around these protected areas to capture wildlife for profit (Destro et al. 2019a). Economic incentives to promote engagement of local populations are options to explore. Yet, as the species that decides the Earth's future, we must learn to co-exist with nature. The most numerous and common species provide the widest range of ecosystem services, it remains to be seen how many more of these can we afford to lose.
