

Camp 3^d Maine Vols near Brandy, Va.

April 30th 1864.

To his Excellency: Samuel Cony,
Governor of Maine.

Sir:

As my term of service expires, on the 4th day of June
next, leaving a vacancy of a Captain, in my Company.
And first Lieutenant, George S. Fuller, leaves the service
at the same time, which leaves the Company without
officers, I would respectfully recommend, that First-Sergt.
C. M. Bursley, of same Company, be commissioned as
Captain, ^{(at that time).} he being fully competent for the position.
He has for the past few months, held a commission
as 2^d Lieutenant, in said Co., but owing to circumstances
over which he had no control, he could not be mustered
as such.

I would further recommend, that George W.
Hubbard, Sergeant of same Company, be commissioned
as first-Lieutenant.
