as I have been home on a furlough, on account of being wounded in the late battle, which was the 4th of May, and that my term of service expires the fourth of June, which is next Saturday, but my furlough extends to the 16 June.

but what I wished to find out is, is they may need of my going ~~to~~ back to Washington to get my discharge,

why cant I go to Augusta and get it just as well, it would please me very much for you to inform ~~me~~ me, my best way, to report to the Hospital I left, or report at Augusta

you would do me a great favor, by answering this - ~~the next week~~
