State of Maire that on the of day of August 1862, I was indisted at Winthood Village Maine, By Dr. J. B. Fillebrown, for Bapitain Michmond, at that time commanding Co Sto, 3° me Job. With the distinct understanding and promise of Balph Richmond that I should be discharged at the same time the ballance of the beginnent was, which was on or about the 2th of last June. I should like to be discharged as I am until for duty from a wound received at Gettysburg Ta July 2 1463; I have the Monor to be very perpetfully you humble servail Q 2, Munch But 60 6, 3 Ma Johs.
