Sir

I have the honor to report to you that on the 7th day of August 1862, I was enlisted at Westbrook Village Maine, by Dr. J. B. Fillebrown, for Captain Richmond, at that time Commanding Co H. 3rd Me Vols.

With the distinct understanding and promise of Capt Richmond that I should be discharged at the same time the ballance of the Regiment was, which was on or about the 21th of last June.

I should like to be discharged as I am unfit for duty from a wound received at Gettysburg Pa July 2^d 1863.
