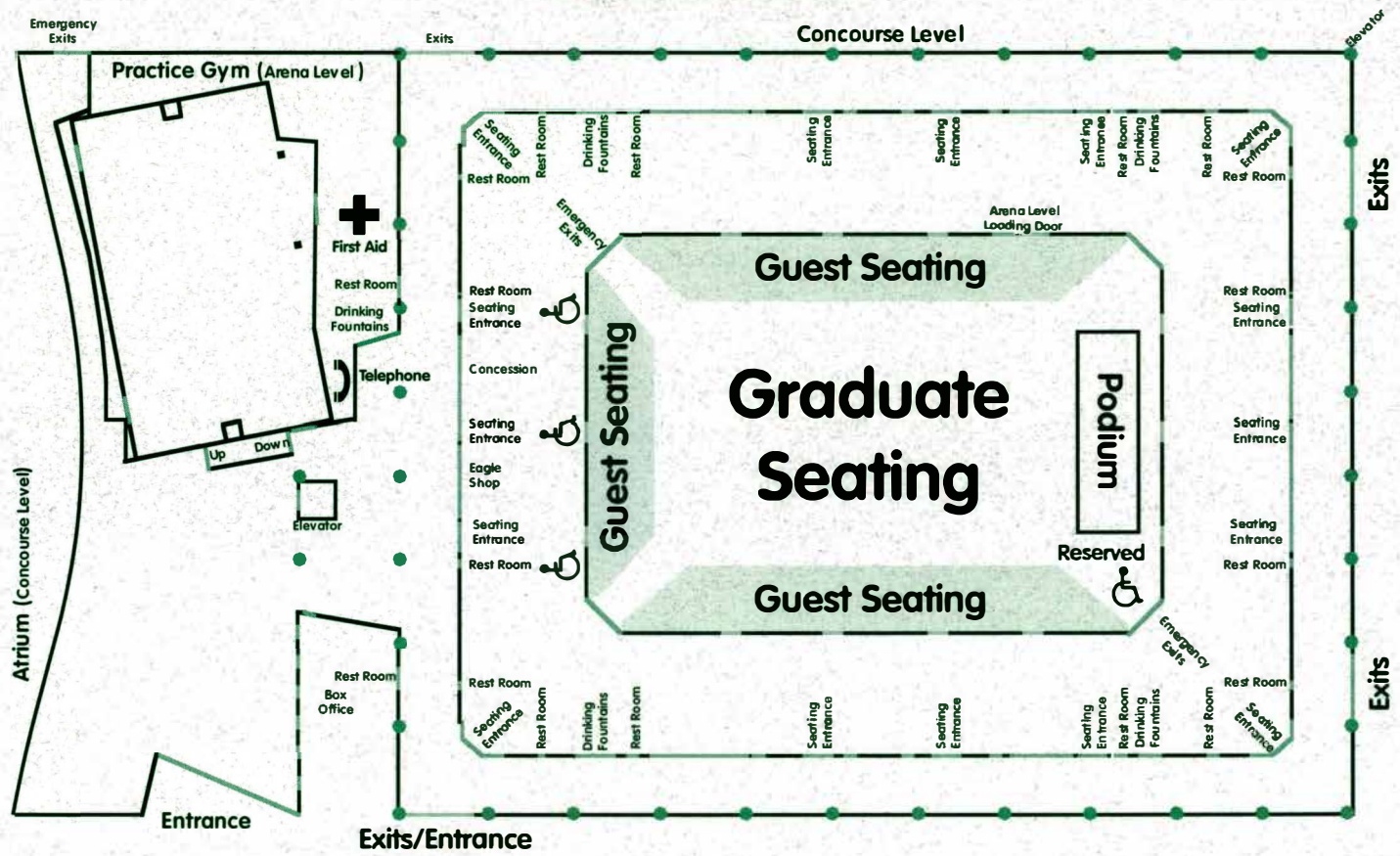

# EASTERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY™

Established by the state of Michigan in 1849 to educate teachers, Eastern Michigan University was founded as Michigan State Normal School and was the first such college west of the Allegheny Mountains. It became Michigan State Normal College in 1899 and then Eastern Michigan College in 1956. With the establishment of several colleges and a graduate school, EMU attained university status in 1959.

The University became a doctoral-granting institution in March 1991, when it was authorized to offer a doctorate in educational leadership. The inaugural class of 10 students was admitted in the fall of that year, and produced its first doctoral graduate in April 1994.

The University, which has a current enrollment of more than 23,000 students, comprises colleges of Arts and Sciences, Business, Education, Health and Human Services, and Technology; the Graduate School; Learning Resources and Technologies; and Extended Programs.

## COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES

The College of Arts and Sciences includes 17 departments and one specialized program and offers most of the courses forming traditional university liberal arts and general education requirements. It provides students with a solid foundation for further work in the college's wide range of major and minor programs, or in specialized curricula in the University's other colleges. Faculty in the college have won national recognition for their teaching excellence and research contributions.

Programs within the college offer superior preparation for rewarding careers. Those in the arts and humanities enable students to understand and interpret the past, to appreciate the finest achievements of art, drama, and music, and to develop essential language and communication skills for a high-technology, ever-shrinking world. Programs in the natural and social sciences promote scientific literacy and provide a solid foundation for the increasing needs of a scientifically knowledgeable population. Emphasis is placed on key terms and concepts, modes of thought and reasoning, and techniques of research and problem-solving.

The college offers students numerous opportunities for enrichment and career exploration. The annual Symposium showcases undergraduate student research and creative activity. Direct student involvement in learning is promoted through independent study, research projects and special activities, internships and cooperative education placements, and the University Honors Program.

## COLLEGE OF BUSINESS

The College of Business develops future business leaders by providing high quality, professionally accredited programs at the undergraduate and graduate levels, and by offering professional development education to the business community. The college values and promotes scholarly research, applications, and an international perspective in each of its programs.

Professional preparation is provided for students interested in administrative careers in business, government agencies, and public administration. Emphasis is placed on a combination of tools, concepts, and theory for practical application to business decisions and business problems.

The college also serves as an educational resource for business firms of regional, national, and international scope and maintains alliances that are mutually beneficial to students, faculty, and the college. Its faculty is professionally recognized for its contributions to the body of knowledge and its understanding of management and business enterprise.

## COLLEGE OF EDUCATION

Eastern Michigan University has long been a national leader in the preparation of teachers and other school personnel. The University was founded in 1849 as Michigan State Normal School, the first teacher-training institution west of the Allegheny Mountains. It was the second normal college in the nation to offer a four-year baccalaureate program for teachers, and the university has grown to become the nation's largest producer of educational personnel.

Over the years, the College of Education has repeatedly been recognized for its outstanding academic performance. Since 1985, the college has earned numerous national awards, including four Showcase for Excellence Awards from the American Association of State Colleges and Universities for model programs that enhance the professional preparation of educators.

The College of Education is composed of four departments and the Office of Academic Services. Its faculty and staff are committed to providing instruction in professional coursework for students preparing for professional education licensure, as well as students in related curricula outside the field of education.

## **COLLEGE OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES**

The College of Health and Human Services prepares professionals with a combination of knowledge and skills that will enable them to enhance the quality of life and facilitate social change to meet societal needs.

The programs in the college focus on the preparation of professionals for a unique combination of health and human services disciplines. As a result, curricula are built around an integration of knowledge with practice. Experiential education that is community-based strongly links theory and practice. The curricula focus on a holistic view of individuals, groups, families, communities, and the process of change. The inter-relationships of people, institutions, and services also are included. One of the unique contributions of the college is its preparation of students for professional roles within the service delivery system.

## **COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY**

The College of Technology seeks to meet the existing and emerging personnel needs of business, industry, and education. The college was established to meet the significant need for trained technologists in a wide variety of industrial positions.

The undergraduate and graduate programs have been designed to provide a solid foundation in mathematics, science, technology, management, and human relations. Program content is practical and is applied with many opportunities for laboratory and cooperative work experiences. Graduates are educated for technological management positions in production, research, and marketing for business and industry. The college is housed in facilities that provide faculty offices, lecture rooms, and laboratories equipped for computer applications, manufacturing, computer-aided design, communication technology, graphic arts, electronics, power, and technology systems.

The college consists of four departments, including Military Science, the University's long-standing program that provides training for and entry into the active Army, Army Reserve, or National Guard as a commissioned officer. The college also houses the Coatings Research Institute, one of the world's foremost centers for coatings-related research.

# ACADEMIC PROCESSION AND SYMBOLS

The academic procession preceding the commencement ceremony is the direct descendant of ecclesiastical processions, which included a stately and orderly movement of celebrants to the place of sacred ceremony. As the church was for centuries the main force behind intellectual enrichment, the religious overtones of the academic procession are not surprising.

The procession begins with the University mace, a symbol of authority of the president and the Board of Regents. The mace represents the golden flame of learning and is carried by the grand marshal, who is chosen on the basis of service to the University. Distinguished faculty lead their colleagues in. The charter, carried by the vice president for university relations, represents the original academic design of the University. The keys, carried by the chief financial officer, represent permission to enter and employ the University's resources for the advancement of knowledge. The colors, carried by the vice president for university marketing and student affairs, symbolizes a heraldic representation of the University. The chief academic officer carries the book representing knowledge, the source of wisdom. The University seal is carried by the vice president for enrollment services. The medallion worn by the president represents the distinguished office of the University's leader. The medallion was designed and created by fine arts professor John Van Haren.

All undergraduates wear gowns of the same color. The colors of the hoods signify the different graduate degrees: arts and sciences – white; business – drab; education – light blue; health and human services – citron; technology – gold; specialist's – purple; and doctoral – green, white, and blue. The custom of wearing gowns stems from the time when all students of higher learning were members of the clergy and wore garments that the church considered appropriate. The wearing of caps dates from early Roman history. The mortarboard may be a combination of the tight-fitting cap worn indoors by the scholars in the Middle Ages and the soft biretta worn outdoors. The tuft of the early cap has been replaced by a tassel. The green and white tassel worn by the graduates represents the colors of Eastern Michigan University.

## **The University Mace**

Historically, the mace was a battle club used by men on horseback to injure footmen. With the passage of time, however, it became a symbol of learning and power.

Constructed of sterling silver, gold-plated brass, and padauk, a wood resembling mahogany, the mace carries the symbols of each area of the University: the arts, business, education, health and human services, the sciences, and technology.

The University mace was designed and constructed by Mark Hall, who earned his bachelor's degree in art from Eastern, and completed requirements for his master's degree in fine arts at the Cranbrook Art Academy.

# COMMENCEMENT SPEAKERS

## **John Engler**

John Engler was elected the 46th governor of the state of Michigan in 1990 and re-elected in 1994 and 1998. Prior to his election as governor, Engler served for 12 years in the Michigan Senate – including seven years as the majority leader – and for eight years in the Michigan House of Representatives. In the 10 times Engler has stood for election to public office, he has never been defeated.

Engler has provided the leadership during a period of remarkable progress in the state of Michigan. During his tenure as governor, Michigan has moved from a \$1.8-billion deficit to a \$1-billion surplus. Unemployment has dropped from the highest rate among industrial states to a record low. At the same time, taxes have been cut 25 times, saving Michigan taxpayers \$11 billion.

Education has been Engler's top priority since he became governor. He led the fight to enact Proposal A, which funded schools fairly while cutting property taxes. Funding for K-12 public schools has increased 56 percent during the 1990s, more than \$4 billion.

Engler established an aggressive business attraction strategy and a locally driven job training system which has helped Michigan attract more major new-job-creating businesses than any other state. More than 750,000 new jobs have been created in Michigan since 1991. Unemployment has dropped from nearly 10 percent to less than four percent and in 1994, Michigan's annual unemployment rate fell below the national average for the first time since 1966. It has remained below the national average for five years in a row.

Engler's welfare reform plan has helped more than 200,000 families achieve independence from cash assistance by finding jobs. His innovative "Project Zero" has helped three communities achieve the unprecedented goal of zero unemployment among welfare recipients.

Under Engler's leadership, Michigan has embarked on the most ambitious road repair plan in state history. A record \$1 billion was committed to road repair during 1998 and an additional \$1.2 billion will be invested this year. During the next 10 years, an additional \$6 billion will be budgeted for road and bridge repair.

Safety also has been a top priority for Engler. To date, he has signed more than 300 bills to reform the criminal justice system, implement truth-in-sentencing, and give new tools to police and prosecutors. Administrative reforms have helped to double prison capacity; the parole system has been revamped to increase accountability; and the supervision

of probationers was strengthened. During Engler's tenure, there has been a 22-percent decrease in violent crime.

A native of Beal City, Engler is the oldest of seven brothers and sisters. He earned a bachelor's degree in agricultural economics from Michigan State University and a law degree from the Thomas M. Cooley Law School. He and his wife, Michelle, also an attorney and the chair of the Michigan Community Service Commission, are the parents of four-year-old triplet daughters, Margaret, Hannah and Madeleine.

## **Alma Wheeler Smith**

Alma Wheeler Smith, a native of Columbia, South Carolina, moved to Ann Arbor, Michigan, with her family in 1943. She graduated from St. Thomas High School in 1959 and received her bachelor of arts degree in journalism from the University of Michigan.

Smith is serving her second term as a Michigan state senator representing the 18th District. The district encompasses most of Washtenaw County, where she has lived for 56 years, and includes the cities of Ypsilanti and Ann Arbor.

She serves as vice chair of the Senate Appropriations Committee and is the first woman to hold a leadership position on that prestigious committee. She also serves on the Higher Education, Community Health, Department of Environmental Quality and Corrections subcommittees.

During her first term in the Senate, Smith sponsored legislation regulating personal protection orders between juveniles and their parents and guardians. She also guided into law a 50-bill technical package and one constitutional amendment that replaced the term "handicap" with "disability," bringing Michigan into conformity with federal terminology. Smith has sponsored key budget amendments on health care and the environment, which have been adopted into law. Her legislative work has been recognized by the Michigan Association of Public Health, the Michigan Secondary Reading Interest Council, the Pro-Choice Network and several local associations in Washtenaw County.

Prior to her election to the Michigan Senate in 1994, Smith served as a member of the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners from 1992 to 1994 and as a trustee for the South Lyon School Board from 1984 to 1992. At the same time, she worked for former State Senator Lana Pollack as her legislative coordinator.

Smith has three adult children.

# THE GRAND MARSHALS

(10 a.m.)

Patricia Ryan joined the faculty in the Department of Sociology, Anthropology and Criminology at EMU in 1966 as an assistant professor, was tenured and promoted to associate professor in 1973, became associate director of the Institute for the Study of Children and Families in 1978, and became administrative director of the institute and was promoted to full professor in 1980. Between 1972 and 1996, she was either director or co-director on more than 30 external grants – most of them having to do with foster care parent training, for which she is internationally known. Indeed, in 1989 Pat received a resolution of commendation from the EMU Board of Regents in recognition of her many achievements over the years.

Pat has authored or co-authored more than 30 articles, chapters, books, and handbooks relating to foster care and foster care training. In addition, Pat has served as keynote speaker or participated in close to 90 workshops and training seminars on foster care. She has also served well the Department of Sociology, Anthropology and Criminology, having chaired numerous standing and ad hoc committees.

Pat recently retired from EMU after more than 32 years of service and was granted emeritus faculty status by the Board of Regents.

Ronald Oestrike earned a bachelor's degree in mathematics and physical education from Eastern Michigan University, and a master's degree in administration from the University of Michigan. He joined the Eastern faculty in the Department of Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance in 1964 as an assistant professor and head baseball coach.

Ron has been involved in a number of professional and academic associations during his tenure at EMU, most notably the American Baseball Coaches Association, the Michigan High School Athletic Association, Sports Sages, and the Association of Track Officials of Michigan. He is a certified instructor of CPR, basic life support, and first aid.

Ron has spent his entire professional life serving the EMU community. His commitment and leadership has been demonstrated in many ways. He was recognized as the 1976 National Coach of the Year, inducted into the EMU Hall of Fame in 1979, and in 1987 the University's baseball stadium was officially named Oestrike Stadium. Ron continues to be involved in athletics and in particular as a volunteer assistant coach for the EMU softball team. He recently retired from the University after 34 years of service and was granted emeritus faculty status by the Board of Regents.

It started with \$13,500 and six acres of land.

Community leaders in Ypsilanti, intent on beating out other Michigan cities for the state's first normal school, made a lucrative proposal to the State Legislature: \$13,500 and six acres, a temporary site to get the school started, and \$700 per year for the first five years to pay the principal's salary.

If the proposal was approved, the leaders of Ypsilanti would create just the ninth teacher's college in North America and the first on what was still considered the American frontier. In 1849, the Michigan Legislature selected the small town of Ypsilanti on the old Chicago Road as the site for the state's first school dedicated to training teachers. It was called Michigan State Normal School. When the first Normal building opened in 1853, four faculty members were entrusted with the mission of providing a "good common school education" for the original 122 students.

In 1999, Eastern Michigan University celebrates the positive difference it has made and continues to make in the lives of its students, its community, and its country with a year-long sesquicentennial celebration. Eastern Michigan University has emerged as a leader in developing new methods of learning, increasing the availability of higher education, and preparing its students for success in a technologically advanced environment. In fact, the University's focus on assessing learning and removing institutional barriers to learning has garnered national attention.

Eastern is the country's leading producer of K-12 educational personnel. When the John W. Porter College of Education Building opens later this year, the University will have one of the country's pre-eminent facilities for the training of teachers. The Porter Building will join the new \$41-million Bruce T. Halle Library, the \$29-million Convocation Center, a soon-to-be-constructed College of Health and Human Services building, and other new facilities as part of Eastern's \$200-million renaissance.

These facilities, as well as a new off-campus site in Livonia, support the University's ongoing efforts toward the delivery of learning. Indeed, as Eastern Michigan University celebrates its sesquicentennial, it also continues to shape the way America learns.
