Your class entered R.I.S.D. on a tragic September day in American history. For some of you the loss was immediate and personal. For others, for one and all, the fall of the twin towers, like the collapse of the tower of Babel in the Bible, closed off our past and opened up an unknown and insecure future. In the scriptural story, those who had dwelt together suddenly ceased to understand one another and heard only babble, not conversation.

Art and design rely each upon each: art recalls and remembers, while design prepares for the future. I spent an evening during this recent, seemingly unending winter, at a senior party hosted by Jethro Rebollar in his eagle's nest apartment just above Benefit at Angell. From the windows you can see all the landmarks of marvelous Providence, where every street name carries a blessing, a prayer, a poem. You can take in the panorama of the entire R.I.S.D. campus as if this were not a garret, an attic with noble ship-shape rafters, a studio loft, but a light-
house over a dark horizon. There is the Waterman building, the museum, the College building, the little toy Armory, the Art Club on Thomas, all at a glimpse and a glance.

Jethro wore a white summer suit the color of the snow. He needed my help to tie the knot of his cravat, which was fun to do. His elegantly dressed classmate guests stood by a neat bar, with a proper tender-server, who prepared Cuban drinks, a nostalgic reference to the island in the sun from which Jethro's family had come to the U.S.A.

I came to know Jethro not only from my classes within Liberal Arts, but from a Tuesday morning routine of coffee together. Sometimes he brought the brew. Other Tuesdays (with me, not Morrie) I stirred the cream and sugar from our staff lounge, for him. During my Sabbatical semester off-campus, we met among the Wickenden Street coffee houses for our long, philosophical and absurdest talks. His Industrial Design senior project was an attempt to
design concepts and ideas for the Future, incorporating the best values of the Past. Notably, the rescue of neighborhood scale, with its liberating freedom from the dangers of de-personalizing globalization. We chatted on about movies, books, and newspaper articles that might fortify his thesis. He has asked me to his final crit.

I only center on Jethro because he is for me a symbol of the dilemma of your destiny. In my early childhood President Franklin Roosevelt had famously declared: "To some generations much is given. From other generations much is expected. This generation has a Rendezvous with Destiny." These words are carved on the garden walls of his memorial in Washington, D.C. Industrial wastes made the waterfront poisonous as well as unpleasant. Now the river attracts tourists and swans and glows with the ever-changing skyline and passing clouds of each season. We have to stand guard over the best of the past even as we create things and spaces for the future. R.I.S.D students appreciate and improve their spaces. We build tomorrow upon yesterday.

I am one who sees the Twin Towers as expressions of our American belief in prosperity for all persons, democracy of aspiration. It is the job and the vocation of artists and designers to heal the wounds of the rubble and the grief with
humane and responsible plans. Not for mere technological "wonders," but for things that last, that recycle, that bring souls together, that help our world, not exploit it. Your class will lead the way into a belief in art that is not just practical and private but a solace. You invent our school with every mark you make with your minds, eyes, and magic fingers.. You put your blessings upon this place with your talented, patient, and gifted hands. Then again, remember my favorite line from James Thurber, the conclusion of "The Thirteen Clocks," a fable about yesterday and tomorrow, the good counsel given by a Golux. "Remember laughter. You'll need it even in the blessed isles of Ever After."

When you look out your window at your corner of the campus, don't say farewell: just take in whatever you see and desire and take it all with you. Your diploma is a deed to what you survey. The Buddha and the Mummy, the porcelains and the mahogany furniture, the library atop the College Building
and the tower above Carr Haus, the noble trees behind Woods Gerry, they are yours by legacy. Who else can lay claim to the property, visible and spiritual, if not you, the alums? You brought R.IS.D with you, and you carry it off or leave it where it stands, to visit whenever you like. In fact, R.I.S.D is your mansion. Go in peace and come home in peace.

When I was growing up in Massachusetts, the only thing I knew about RISD was that David Macaulay taught there. In fourth grade, I had decided that I would become an architect, and Macaulay's books, especially Cathedral and City, were my inspiration. I started drawing elaborate floor plans and cross-sections of cafeterias as part of a fanciful redesign of my junior high school and thought that I, too, might get to walk the halls of the impressively-named Rhode Island School of Design, greet Mr. Macaulay outside one of its ivy-covered buildings, and discuss our latest projects. Over time, I shifted toward illustration and graphic design, making hundreds of pen-and-ink drawings, taking a cartooning class, learning offset lithography, and serving as production editor of the high school literary magazine. In my freshman year at college (I went to a large university), I displayed my accumulated pen-and-ink work (including incredibly detailed narrative murals and surrealist self-portraits) in the hallway outside my dorm room.

I even daydreamed of transferring to art school and, then, like all those British rock stars, pursuing a thrilling bohemian life as a former art student/guitarist.

By the end of college, however, I had long forgotten about art. (And I think that those of you that know me will agree that it is for the best that I did not attempt to become a British rock star). Actually, my drifting away began earlier. First, there was the "Daniel" I received in Algebra, which had led my guidance counselors to steer me away from architecture and engineering (for some reason it was linked in their minds). And I never did quite fit in with the "art kids" in school, who tended to congregate in the back parking lot to coolly smoke and laugh at geeks like me. In the end, I pursued other interests I had in journalism, literature, and music. I wanted to be a novelist, mostly, and then I discovered that I loved teaching and never looked back. In fact, during the six years I spent at Brown working
on a Ph.D. in American Civilization, I never once felt enough curiosity about RISD to go down the hill and check it out.

I forgot, that is, until I got my first part-time teaching job- at RISD, of all places. It was all an accident: someone had called my department at Brown, looking for a lastminute fill-in for a film course, and I was in the office at the time. Mind you, my RISD employment had absolutely nothing to do with my earlier art aspirations: I was hired because I was an Americanist, with specialties in media studies and popular culture theory. And I must admit that RISD's art and design culture was the strangest thing I had ever experienced (I remember wondering, "What on earth is 'a crit?' Is it a bad thing?"). But I soon realized that working at RISD helped to connect together parts of my life that were not connected before. I have never met David Macaulay and have yet to draw again, but I have been able to rediscover that I once imagined life as an artist and that
my teaching and writing about American culture, at RISD, is a way to acknowledge, but also project in new directions, the reverberating echo of who I once wanted to be.

Unlike Sigmund Freud, who posited a rather fixed, inner, psychic structure, formed in childhood, William James argued that we are constantly shaping our identities as we live our lives, connecting our many selves in different contexts, over time, into a coherent and stable sense of personhood. (James himself had been, as he put it, a "twice-born soul," and shifted ably from career to careerartist, physiologist, psychologist, philosopher- throughout his life). I like James's vision because it avoids the usual angst and hardened categories about what we are "meant" to do in life. You should have goals, of course, but there's no use in fetishizing them, especially if they aren't working. You simply can't predict what forces and circumstances will direct your actions or which ways you will choose to
employ your abilities. I am not suggesting that you simply give yourself up to fate (that usually results in a grim existence in your parents' basement, watching television for hours on end). The point is that each of you need to understand that living well involves a somewhat mysterious process of responding flexibly, and with humor, to all the unforeseen events and trials and choices presented by daily life while holding on to some sort of core understanding of continuity-what you believe and who you understand yourself to be--amidst the change

Some of you are going to become practicing artists and designers, some of you will not. Some of you will find your classes immediately applicable to tasks and problems; others may not see the relevance right away. But your experiences at RISD never will have been useless; no matter what each of you do, your time and work here is one of the significant elements that will shape your identity. In some
ways, my story, so far, has moved in the opposite direction than yours. I became a scholar and, by arriving at RISD, found new personal connections to the world of art. You are full-fledged artists who, by leaving RISD, will shape different life stories--who knows how you will connect your time at RISD to other contexts, other passions, other experiences? That is what is most exciting about education, I think: you will realize, and build on, your learning in multiple, and even contradictory, ways. (Let the state test that "outcome"!) All you need to do is go, try hard to find ways to practice your vocation, embrace the seeming tangents and unforeseen opportunities, and do it all with enthusiasm. It's not easy, but, in the process, you make yourselves.
