• White identity is an important subject of study in the United States (see Jardina, 2019; 2021; Schildkraut, 2017; Valentino and Sears, 2005)

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- Evaluation of its effect on political attitudes and vote choice alike



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- Study by Beauvais and Stolle (2022) evaluates the effect of white identity on political behavior
- Strongly associated with voting for the Bloc Québécois, Catholicism and Protestanism (as opposed to agnostics/atheists)
- Like for Jardina in the US case, Beauvais and Stolle don't necessarily find a strong relation between white identity and racial resentment in Canada
- Or that white identity does not correlate as much with voting Conservative while - (Indigenous resentment correlates with voting Conservative and not significantly with voting for the Bloc Québécois)

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- Some studies in the US suggest it might be a better explanation
- We delve into it by evaluating the opinion of white Canadians about systemic racism and on measures to tackle inequality between black Canadians and the rest of the population

• 1: Is there white anxiety in Canada? - Are Whites feeling threatened or discriminated against?

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- 2: Who is anxious? Sociodemographic factors associated with self-perceived discrimination among Whites in Canada

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- 2: Who is anxious? Sociodemographic factors associated with self-perceived discrimination among Whites in Canada
- 3: What are the consequences of white anxiety on measures to counter inequalities (in this case between black Canadians and the rest of the population) or on opinion on systemic racism in Canada (and to some extent on vote choice)?



• Social and economic inequalities (Banting, and Thompson, 2021; Houle, 2019)

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- Higher unemployment rates than the rest of the population. Exceptionally high third generation black Canadians (8-12% for all generations while lower than 8% for the rest of the population in 2016)
- The annual salary was around 41000\$ for black men in 2015, while the rest of the population was 56000\$.

Why Black Canadians?

• 27% of black children in Canada live in low income while it is 14% for other children.

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- 1.2% of MPS in the Canadian parliament in 2019 while 3.5% of the population
- Basically, many socioeconomic indicators that would justify state intervention with policies to correct inequalities between Blacks and the rest of the population
- And that could trigger opposition from White voters, like in the United States, against measures to correct inequalities or systemic racism overall

Data

• Module in the 2021 Canadian Election Study (CES)

Data

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- n=2005, with 1688 white respondents

Independent variable

• IV: White anxiety measured with a single item

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- IV: In your opinion, how much discrimination is there in Canada today against each of the following groups?: White people (Schildkraudt, 2017)

Dependent variables

• DV's: Questions on attitudes related to black racial inequalities (or ways to correct them) in Canada (inspired by the American Election Study)

Dependent variables: Police and racial justice

• Question: On the following scale where 1 means "fairly" and 7 "unfairly", how do you think the police treats Black people compared to White people in Canada?

Dependent variables: Government intervention


• Question: Some people feel that the government in Ottawa should make every effort to improve the social and economic position of Black people. Others feel that the government should not make any special effort to help Black people. And, of course, some other people have opinions somewhere in between. Where would you place yourself on the following scale?

Dependent variables: Imposition of quotas

• Question: Personally, do you think we should impose quotas so that there are more Black people in politics/in public service?



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




Perceived discrimination against white people in Canada






Effect of white anxiety: Systemic racism


Effect of white anxiety: Government intervention


Effect of white anxiety: Quotas



White anxiety


- A plurality of Whites think there is no discrimination against them




Quebecers' perceived level of discrimination against each racial group in Canada


