Collections and Electronic Resources Updates – 2022 Q4

The following information contains updates to the University Libraries (UL) collections and electronic resources for the 4th quarter of 2022. We are providing this information to update you about resources you are gaining or losing access to in the collection. We plan to publish collections and electronic resource changes quarterly to keep the campus community updated. Additions

Journals

UL continues to expand its read and publish deals. Through OhioLINK, UL has entered into a read and publish deal with IOP (Institute of Physics) which covers physics, materials science, biosciences, astronomy and astrophysics, environmental sciences, and mathematics. The upgrade, starting January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2025, expands Electronic Journal Center (EJC) access to all 72 IOP journals, adding open-access publishing benefits for authors.

To assist in tracking our increasing Open Access Publishing deals, UL has created an Open Access Publishing Library Guide. This guide lists our deals with IOP, Wiley, Cambridge, and the Company of Biologists and directs you to FAQs for each publisher. For any additional questions, please contact mmcgurr1@uakron.edu.

E-books

The Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) collections are now available. As a reminder, here is what is available and the access levels.

Cancellations

While UL continues to work hard on cost control and budget management, some cancellations are still necessary at this time for us to be able to meet all of our commitments.

University Libraries will provide as much notice as possible when resources are to be discontinued in an effort to lessen disruption to our users. Reductions to library collections will continue to be shared via Digest updates and directly with departments. JoVE Core Science Videos and Lab Manual Access Ended December 31st, 2022. In 2021, OhioLINK was awarded GEER funds through the Ohio Department of Higher Education to support the education community during the public health emergency. The Jove subscription included two years of access, from 1/1/2021 – 12/31/2022.
