Evaluation of Dexamethasone Premedication Prescribing for Docetaxel

INTRODUCTION:

- Docetaxel is an antineoplastic agent that is generally well tolerated
- It is recommended to premedicate with corticosteroids such as dexamethasone to reduce the incidence and severity of adverse reactions:
- Fluid retention
- Hypersensitivity reactions

OBJECTIVE:

• Evaluate whether Intermountain Healthcare's (IHC) prescribing patterns follow docetaxel's package insert dexamethasone premedication recommendation

METHODS:

- Retrospective chart review, docetaxel doses prescribed in any outpatient regimen between February 1, 2022, to April 30, 2022
- Data collection included Utah-based treatment facility locations, indication, first docetaxel treatment date, and appropriate docetaxel premedication prescription
- Inclusion criteria: Any docetaxel regimen prescribed at a Utah-based IHC outpatient facility. First treatments initiated before February 2022 were also included.
- Exclusions criteria: Any docetaxel regimens initiated after April 2022

RESULTS:


- 77 docetaxel regimens were recorded during this timeline
- 58.44% (45 out of 77) regimens were prescribed dexamethasone prior to their docetaxel treatment
- 38.96% (30 out of 77) regimens were not prescribed dexamethasone prior to their docetaxel treatment
- 2 regimens were prescribed dexamethasone during the middle of their treatment cycle
- Treatment indications:
- Breast (46)
- Prostate (12)
- Non-Small Cell Lung Cancer (NSLCL) (10)
- Other (10)**
- IHC facility locations most likely prescribing dexamethasone:
- Intermountain Medical Center
- St. George
- Logan
- Cedar City

CONCLUSION:

- 58.44% of docetaxel regimens were appropriately prescribed dexamethasone as premedication for docetaxel as per the manufacturer's recommendation
- Further investigation into the prevalence of docetaxel adverse events and providing education about the importance of anti-cancer therapy premedication are future considerations for this project

- Ovarian
- Gastroesophageal
- Osteosarcoma
- Uterine Leiomyosarcoma
- Spindle Cell
- Small Cell Lung Cancer
