In looking over my accounts kept for the benefit of Capt. C. D. Robinson, during the year 1862. I have found a receipt in your favor, signed by Capt. J. Springstead, A. Q. M. dated May 25, 1862 for 147.702 lbs. cow, taken from your Store House in Fredericksburgh, "by authority of Genl. Patrick."
