Dear Sir:

Yours of the 18th from
Phila is rec'd. it will be impossible for me to be in
Washington D.C. after the 2^d day of May. This Army
will move about that date and I cannot be absent
from my command after we move, for, God only knows
when, if ever

I shall have an opportunity to go to Washing-
ton on the 29th of April & return to camp on the 1st
of May, and if you choose to remit me 50¢. and
I find the same in my P.O. Box 94, at Washington
on the 30th inst, I will then send you by mail the
Receipt spoken of - it will not any more than pay me
for my trouble and expense

Regarding the Lumber & Saws, once spoken of
before I am compiling some information that will assist you,
