60 minute in-person session or 5 mini recorded sessions w/ quiz and activity

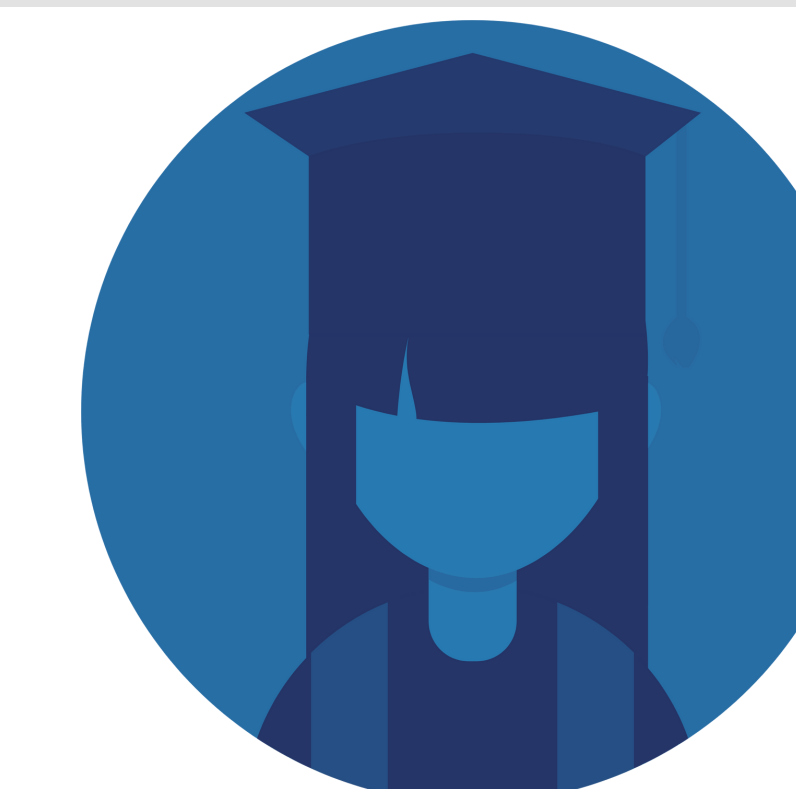
Optional Canvas Course Video Tutorials & Discussion Posts

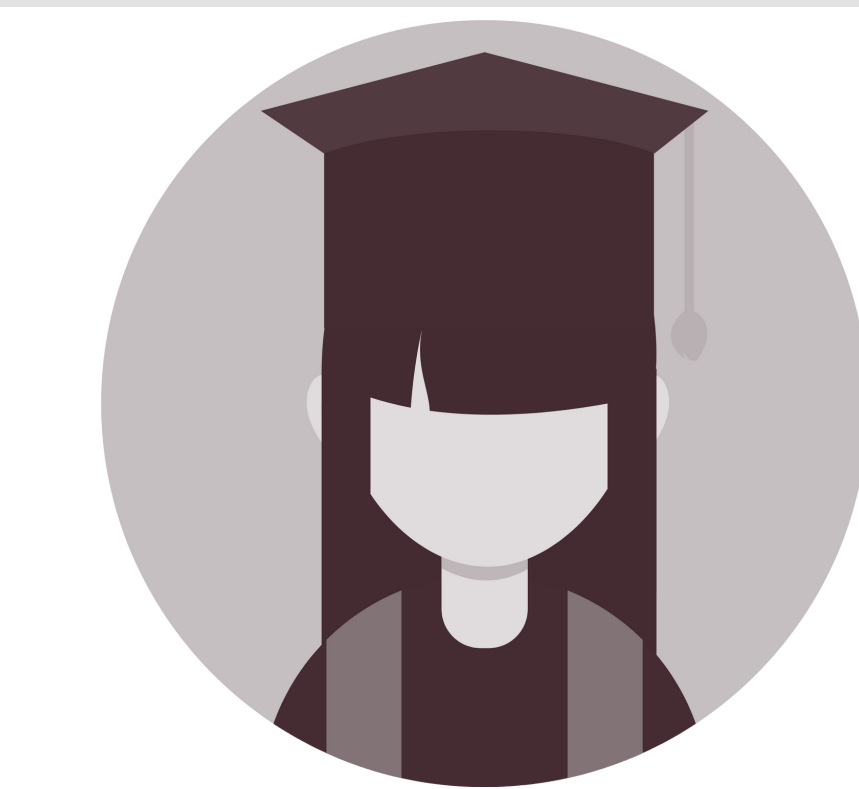
