The *Bibliography of Pragmatics Online* covers the broad field of linguistic pragmatics, conceived as the interdisciplinary – cognitive, social, and cultural – science of natural language use.

It incorporates all the bibliographical data from the renowned Comprehensive Bibliography of Pragmatics (1987), edited by Jan Nuyts & Jef Verschueren (IPrA Research Center), 4 vols., 2197 pp.

Entries of reviews, translations and reprints are linked to the record of the original publication. The search engine is enhanced by a thesaurus. Each annual update provides the relevant recent data.
