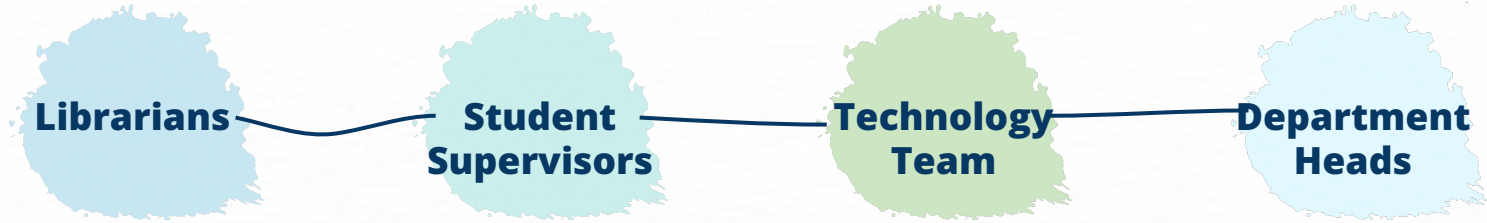

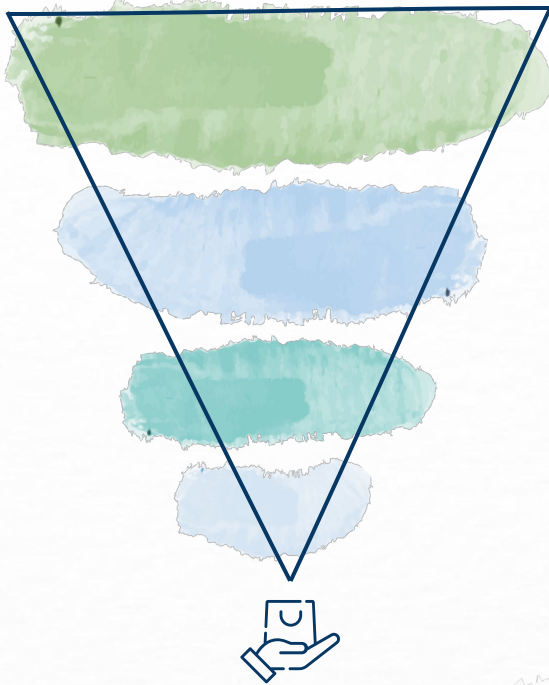

Our Team Diversity



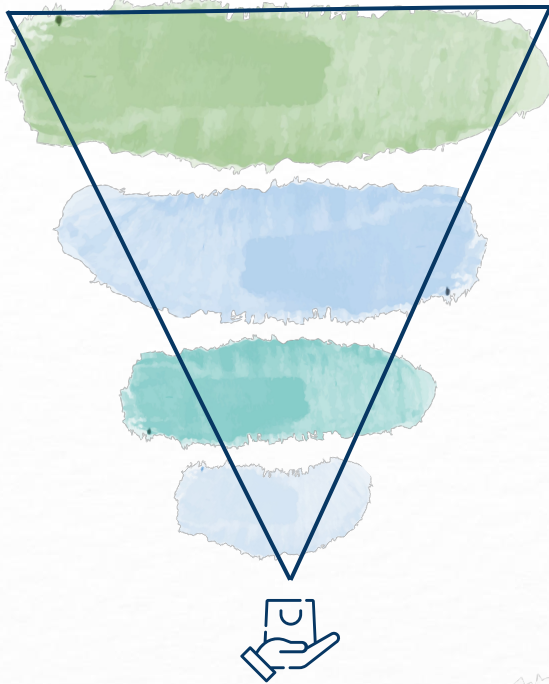
With our goal of shared governance our work group quickly became large and unwieldy.
