Each book (and I'm proud to have them all) has shown such increasing versatility and command that it makes one look forward impatiently

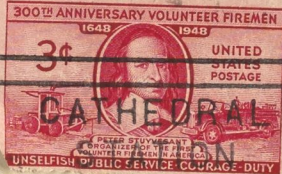
for more. In the meantime
