Jasmin Abdunazarova

Jasmin Abdunazarova was born and raised in a musician's family in Uzbekistan. She started to play the piano at the age of 3 and had her first recital at age 6, performing compositions by Bach, Mozart, and others. At her young age, Jasmin has already amassed an impressive array of musical accomplishments from winning competitions, including Grand Prizes in "A. Rubinstein," "A.

Dvarionaite," "S. Rachmaninov," "Citta di Barletta," the Special prize of "Paulo Serrao," as well as many other competitions and, as a result, the Ministry of the Republic of Uzbekistan awarded her with the "Tasanno" prize. She performed the Saint Saens Piano Concerto No. 2 and the Mozart Piano Concerto No. 23 with the "Turkistan" orchestra in Tashkent. Jasmin participated in Masterclasses with "Y. Bashmet Summer Academy," where she studied with R. Krimer and chamber with I. Fedotov, "Lake Como Summer Piano Academy," where she studied with S. Ioudenitch, W. Nabore, and A. Chow. During her time there, she also took master classes with Alexander Wasserman, and was invited to play in a master class with Barry Douglas which was on March 15th, 2023. She graduated from Uspensky School of Music, Tashkent, where she studied with R. Abdunazarov, and at this moment, she is pursuing her Bachelor's degree in Piano at Lynn Conservatory of Music in the studio of Roberta Rust. Besides playing piano, Jasmin does yoga and rhythmic gymnastics, and also she is a member of an organization called "Respect the Water," which takes care of nature.
