NN/LM Mission

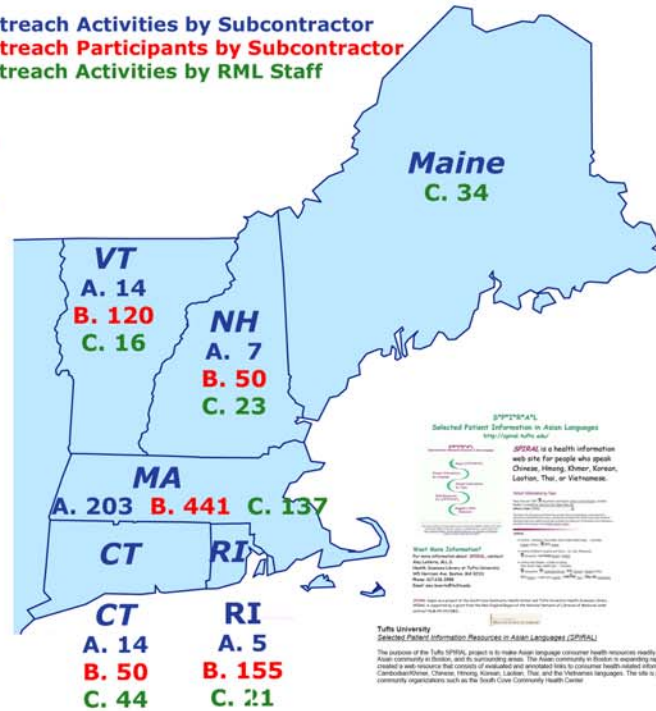
