Benson went to New England Financial from his position as COO of Equitable Companies, Inc. and president and CEO of its flagship life insurance operation, Equitable Life Assurance Society. He is a graduate of the University of Illinois with a BA in economics and earned his MBA at the University of Southern California. He holds the Chartered Life Underwriter designation. Benson is active in many industry and community organizations and is founder and chair of World T.E.A.M. Sports, providing opportunities through sports activities for people with physical and mental disabilities.



## Orit Gadiesh Doctor of Business Administration

Chairman and CEO of Bain & Company, Boston, one of the largest global strategic management companies. Gadiesh is a widely acknowledged expert on management and corporate strategy, advising top-level managers throughout the world on critical issues. Prior to joining Bain in 1977, Gadiesh served in the Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff of the Israeli Army. She holds a BA, summa cum laude, from Hebrew University, Jerusalem, and an MBA with highest honors, the Baker's Scholar, and Brown Award from the Harvard Business School. She is renowned for inspiring leadership and high energy levels and credited for turning Bain & Company around following her election as its chairman in 1993.

Previously, Mr. Wolfe led Tytronics, Inc., the founding company of Metrisa, Inc., and has held senior positions in other engineering organizations. He holds a BS degree in electrical engineering from Worcester Polytechnic Institute and an MS in management from Massachusetts Institute of Technology as an Alfred P. Sloan Fellow. He has been a Bryant College trustee since 1987. His three-year term as chairman, from 1995-1998, is marked with stellar success, including the initiation of The New Century Plan for Excellence, a strategy to guide Bryant's leadership into the next millennium.

Students must have completed sixty (60) semester hours of work at Bryant College to be eligible for honors.

- Beta Gamma Sigma Beta Gamma Sigma is the highest national recognition a student can receive in an undergraduate program in business or management accredited by AACSB-The International Association for Management Education. To be eligible for membership a student must have earned a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 and rank in the upper seven percent of the junior class or upper ten percent of the senior class.
- ø Omicron Delta Epsilon Founded in 1915, Omicron Delta Epsilon is one of the world's largest international academic honor societies and there has been a chapter at Bryant College since 1969. It is dedicated to the encouragement of excellence in economics. To be eligible for membership a student must have completed a minimum of 12 semester hours of economics courses, have earned at least a "B" average in the economics courses and have an overall scholastic average of "B" or better.

A Lambda Pi Eta - Lambda Pi Eta is an accredited member of the Association of College Honor Societies. It is the official communication studies honor society of the National Communication Association. To be eligible for membership, students must have a completed at least 12 hours of communication courses, have a GPA of at least 3.25, and be in the upper thirty-five percent of the graduating class.

**hp Honors Program** - The Honors Program is an enriched educational experience for academically talented students. To be recognized as an Honors Program graduate a student must have successfully completed six challenging courses enhanced with a specially designed honors component.

## The Harriet C. Jacobs Memorial Mace

The College Mace is carried at Commencement exercises and at other College celebrations. Crowned in gold, the mace has the two dominant emblems of the institution: the seal of the State of Rhode Island and the seal of Bryant College.

## The President's Chair

The President's Chair, a gift to the College from Priscilla Angelo and her husband, John Eng-Wong, is used on ceremonial occasions. It is a walnut Victorian style gent's chair copied from an original French design from the period of the College's founding in 1863. The carved crest top includes the Bryant College bronze seal.

# **Bryant Medallion**

The Bryant Medallion is worn by the president during academic ceremonies such as Commencement, Convocation, and the bestowal of honorary degrees. One side of the medallion bears a likeness of the College seal, the other, the names of all Bryant College presidents. The formal installation of presidents is marked by the presentation of the medallion by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees to the president.

# The Bryant Seal

The Bryant Seal represents the educational mission of the College and its worldwide implications. The central symbol is an ellipsoid globe with quills on each side to signify the traditional emblem of communication in business. In the center, behind the globe, is a torch symbolizing liberty, the spirit of free inquiry, academic freedom, and learning. The Archway, forming the background for the globe, torch, and quills, is a College landmark affectionately remembered by thousands of alumni. The Latin motto expresses the purpose of the College: "Educando Dirigere Mercaturam" – Education for Business Leadership.

# Academic Heraldry

The history of academic dress worn today dates back to the universities of the Middle Ages. A statute of 1321 required the wearing of gowns by all scholars and clerics. Probably the warm gown and hood were practical in the unheated buildings.

Students at most American universities were caps and gowns daily while in residence until after the Civil War. These varied in design until they were standardized by the American Inter-collegiate Commission in 1895. While the academic costume code has been modified over the years, the general characteristics of the initial requirements still prevail. The uniform system of academic heraldry serves to indicate the level of degree, the field of study in which it was earned, and the institution by which it was granted. The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve and can be worn open or closed. The gown for the doctor's degree has bell-shaped sleeves with black velvet facing down the front and three bars of the same across the sleeves. However, these facings and crossbars may be in the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains. At Bryant College, the president and the honorary degree recipients wear gowns especially designed and trimmed in the College color of gold.

Academic hoods are lined with the color of the university granting the degree. The border of the hood is in the color of the discipline in which the degree was earned. For example, colors associated with different subjects include: light brown (or sapphire blue) for commerce, accountancy, business; copper for economics; light blue for education; peacock blue for public administration; purple for law; and white for arts, letters, humanities.

The length of the hood varies slightly for bachelor's and master's, and doctor's degree. Today, the hood for those receiving a bachelor's degree has been replaced by the mortarboard or cap with long tassels in black or in the color appropriate to the subject. It is often the tradition of the candidates for degrees to wear the tassel on the right front side before the degree is conferred and to shift it to the left when the degree is awarded.
