### Robert K. Kraft Doctor of Business Administration

Owner and CEO of the New England Patriots; owner of Foxboro Stadium. In success story followed by millions of sports fans, Patriots won the American Football Conference championship in 1997, participating in the Super Bowl for only the second time in the franchise's history. President of Rand-Whitney Group and the International Forest Products Group of Companies that together comprise one of the largest privately owned paper and packaging companies in the nation. Chairs Chestnut Hill Management, money management firm specializing in equity management. From 1986 to 1991, major stockholder and president of WHDH-AM and WHDH-TV, CBS (Now NBC) television network affiliate in Boston. Attended Columbia University on academic scholarship and received fellowship to the Harvard School of Business where he earned M.B.A.



### Henrique de Campos Meirelles Doctor of Business Administration

International financier, president and chief operating officer of BankBoston, super-regional bank holding company with assets of \$62.3 billion and 23,000 employees. Native of Brazil, joined BankBoston in 1974 as managing director of Boston Leasing; became vice president of bank in Sao Paulo in 1978; appointed head of the Commercial Bank in Brazil two years later; promoted to deputy country manager in 1981; president and regional manager of BankBoston in Brazil in 1984. Degree in civil engineering from University of Sao Paulo, M.B.A. from Federal University of Rio de Janeiro; completed Advanced Management Program at Harvard Business School. Board chairman of Brazilian Association of International Banks; former executive director of Brazilian Federation of Banks. Named "Most Influential Banker of the Year" in 1996 by Latin Trade magazine.

### Barbara A. Papitto '83, '85 MBA Doctor of Business Administration

Member of the Bryant Board of Trustees from 1987 through 1996 when named honorary trustee. Earned both B.S. and M.B.A. degrees at Bryant; chaired the Bryant Annual Fund drive from 1985-87; provided leadership on both Executive Alumni Board and the Graduate School Advisory Council. Also very active as a community leader: past president of the Nickerson House Community Center in Providence, R.I., where she chaired a successful one million-dollar capital campaign; member of the corporation of St. Mary's Home for Children in North Providence; guild member of the Hibiscus Children's Center in Jensen Beach, Fla.; served as an allocation panel member of the Emergency and Disaster Services Panel of the United Way.



### Christian Schwarz-Schilling Doctor of Business Administration

Native of Innsbruck, Austria, educated in Germany; joined Christian Democratic Party and member of Parliament for 37 years, focusing on economic political developments. In 1982, became minister of Post and Telecommunications, heading the largest single government owned company, the German Bundespost, with more than half million employees. When minister of Posts and Telecommunications in 1990, liberalized telecommunications services in Germany; actions led to privatization of government-owned telecommunications entity and opened door to private competition. Is international arbitrator in the Bosnian peace negotiations and, from onset of crisis in former Yugoslavia, has worked to end the strife. Received degree in Sinology (Chinese language, literature and civilization) and doctorate of philosophy from Ludwig-Maximilian University in Munich.

Beta Gamma Sigma is the highest national recognition a student can receive in an undergraduate program in business or management accredited by the American Assembly of Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB). To be eligible for membership a student must have earned a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 and rank in the upper seven percent of the junior class or upper ten percent of the senior class.

#### Omicron Delta Epsilon

Founded in 1915, Omicron Delta Epsilon is one of the world's largest academic honor societies and there has been a chapter at Bryant College since 1969. \$\phi\$ is dedicated to the encouragement of excellence in economics. To be eligible for membership a student must have completed a minimum of 12 semester hours of economics courses, have earned at least a "B" average in the economics courses and have an overall scholastic average of "B" or better.

### The Harriet C. Jacobs Memorial Mace

The College Mace is carried at Commencement exercises and at other College celebrations. Crowned in gold, the mace has the two dominant emblems of the institution: the seal of the State of Rhode Island and the seal of Bryant College.

### The President's Chair

The President's Chair, a gift to the College from Priscilla Angelo and her husband, John Eng-Wong, is used on ceremonial occasions. It is a walnut Victorian style gent's chair copied from an original French design from the period of the College's founding in 1863. The carved crest top includes the Bryant College bronze seal.

# **Bryant Medallion**

The Bryant Medallion is worn by the president during academic ceremonies such as Commencement, Convocation, and the bestowal of honorary degrees. One side of the medallion bears a likeness of the College seal, the other, the names of all Bryant College presidents. The formal installation of presidents is marked by the presentation of the medallion by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees to the president.

# The Bryant Seal

The Bryant Seal represents the educational mission of the College and its worldwide implications. The central symbol is an ellipsoid globe with quills on each side to signify the traditional emblem of communication in business. In the center, behind the globe, is a torch symbolizing liberty, the spirit of free inquiry, academic freedom, and learning. The Archway, forming the background for the globe, torch, and quills, is a College landmark affectionately remembered by thousands of alumni. The Latin motto expresses the purpose of the College: "Educando Dirigere Mercaturam" – Education for Business Leadership.

## Alumni Charge

Commencement is not an ending, but a beginning. Your relationship with your Alma Mater will not end today, but rather evolve into a new form. In Latin, Alma Mater means "fostering mother" and alumnus meant originally "foster child."

## Academic Heraldry

The history of academic dress worn today dates back to the universities of the Middle Ages. A statute of 1321 required the wearing of gowns by all scholars and clerics. Probably the warm gown and hood were practical in the unheated buildings.

Students at most American universities were caps and gowns daily while in residence until after the Civil War. These varied in design until they were standardized by the American Inter-collegiate Commission in 1895. While the academic costume code has been modified over the years, the general characteristics of the initial requirements still prevail. The uniform system of academic heraldry serves to indicate the level of degree, the field of study in which it was earned, and the institution by which it was granted. The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve and can be worn open or closed. The gown for the doctor's degree has bell-shaped sleeves with black velvet facing down the front and three bars of the same across the sleeves. However, these facings and crossbars may be in the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains. At Bryant College, the president and the honorary degree recipients wear gowns especially designed and trimmed in the College color of gold.

Academic hoods are lined with the color of the university granting the degree. The border of the hood is in the color of the discipline in which the degree was earned. For example, colors associated with different subjects include: light brown (or sapphire blue) for commerce, accountancy, business; copper for economics; light blue for education; peacock blue for public administration; purple for law; and white for arts, letters, humanities.

The length of the hood varies slightly for bachelor's and master's, and doctor's degree. Today, the hood for those receiving bachelor's and master's degrees has been replaced by the mortarboard or cap with long tassels in black or in the color appropriate to the subject. It is often the tradition of the candidates for degrees to wear the tassel on the right front side before the degree is conferred and to shift it to the left when the degree is awarded.
