This award is presented to a bachelor's degree candidate who has excelled in his or her military science studies and other courses and who has shown superior leadership potential in the military science program and in extracurricular activities.

This award is presented to a graduate who, in the opinion of the Faculty of the Department of Accounting, has demonstrated excellence in accounting studies and intends to pursue a career in public accounting.

## Robert Holland, Jr. Doctor of Business Administration

President and chief executive officer of Ben & Jerry's Homemade, Inc., a Vermont corporation well known for its ice cream and frozen yogurt; previously served as chairman and chief executive officer of Rokher-J., Inc., a New York-based holding company participating in business development projects and providing strategy development assistance to senior management of major corporations; member of the board of directors of Mutual of New York, TrueMark Manufacturing Company, and Frontier Corporation; chairman of the board of trustees of Spelman College and a trustee of Atlanta University Center; graduate of Union College and Bernard Baruch Graduate School.

Judge for the United States Court of Appeals for the First Circuit; member of the Rhode Island, American, and Federal Bar associations; former chairman of the Bryant College board of trustees; chairman of Lifespan, the parent corporaPMiriam and Rhode Island Hospitals; serves on the Dorcas Place Advisory Board, an organization that assists women in need; recipient of the 1988 Louis D. 


## Marcy Syms Doctor of Business Administration

## Recognition of President William E. Trueheart



William E. Trueheart, Bryant College's Sixth President has provided exceptional service to the College. He has contributed to Bryant as Trustee, Executive Vice President, and President for more than 15 years. Under his leadership Bryant College attained AACSB accreditation, enriched its academic curriculum, diversified its student body, expanded its endowment, and maintained financial stability. He is the first African American to serve as President of a private college in New England.

With characteristic vision, Dr. Trueheart initiated the Entrepreneurial Training Program, Project Venture and an exciting fusion of business and the arts in the RISD/Bryant Connection. Having attracted an internationally recognized faculty to Bryant, he broadened the College's intellectual scope by instituting an extensive and challenging liberal arts program.


Dr. Trueheart has been a visionary leader, a singular mentor to students and colleagues, and a tireless advocate for community service. For all that he has done, and for his selfless leadership on our behalf, Bryant College offers its most sincere thanks.

## Bryant College Lifetime Achievement Award

Senator Claiborne deB. Pell has had a uniquely distinguished career of public service spanning over 36 years. Before beginning six consecutive terms as a U.S. Senator in 1961, he served in a variety of foreign posts in the United States Foreign Service and in the State Department in Washington. His international experience and perceptive insights have made him an invaluable counselor to several presidents, and a respected Senate leader on foreign policy, as well as domestic issues. Senator Pell says, "I have a seven word definition of my job and my life: Translate ideas into events, and serve people."

His Senate career has been characterized by this zeal for serving others, by his tireless advocacy for higher education, and by an inspired insistence that education be accessible to students from all economic backgrounds. Senator Pell's support of student financial aid has opened the doors of opportunity for millions of college students, and has personally benefitted thousands of Bryant's students. His leadership was recognized by Congress when they named the Pell Grant, the nation's largest student grant program, in his honor.

In 1962, Bryant College had the honor of awarding Senator Pell his first honorary degree. Since then he has received 45 other honorary degrees and countless honors. Today, Bryant College is pleased to welcome this highly accomplished yet self-effacing public servant back to campus to receive the first Bryant College Lifetime Achievement Award. The award commemorates Senator Pell's lifetime of service, his lasting legacy of learning, and his profound and enduring influence for good in our nation and world.

## **Academic Heraldry**

The history of academic dress worn today dates back to the universities of the Middle Ages. A statute of 1321 required the wearing of gowns by all scholars and clerics. Probably the warm gown and hood were practical in the unheated buildings.

Students at most American universities wore caps and gowns daily while in residence until after the Civil War. These varied in design until they were standardized by the American Inter-collegiate Commission in 1895. While the academic costume code has been modified over the years, the general characteristics of the initial requirements still prevail. The uniform system of academic heraldry serves to indicate the level of degree, the field of study in which it was earned, and the institution by which it was granted. The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve and can be worn open or closed. The gown for the doctor's degree has bell-shaped sleeves with black velvet facing down the front and three bars of the same across the sleeves. However, these facings and crossbars may be in the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains. At Bryant College, the president and the honorary degree recipients wear gowns especially designed and trimmed in the College color of gold.

The academic hoods are lined with the color of the university granting the degree. The border of the hood is in the color of the discipline in which the degree was earned. For example, colors associated with different subjects include: light brown (or sapphire blue) for commerce, accountancy, business; copper for economics; light blue for education; peacock blue for public administration; purple for law; and white for arts, letters, humanities.

The length of the hood varies slightly for bachelor's and master's, and doctor's degree. Today, the hood for those receiving bachelor's and master's degrees has been replaced by the mortarboard or cap with long tassels in black or in the color appropriate to the subject. It is often the tradition of the candidates for degrees to wear the tassel on the right front side before the degree is conferred and to shift it to the left when the degree is awarded.

## The Harriet C. Jacobs Memorial Mace

The College mace is carried at Commencement exercises and at other College celebrations. Crowned in gold, the mace has the two dominant emblems of the institution: the seal of the State of Rhode Island and the seal of Bryant College.

## The President's Chair

The President's Chair, a gift to the College from Priscilla Angelo and her husband, John Eng-Wong, is used on ceremonial occasions. It is a walnut Victorian style gent's chair copied from an original French design from the period of the College's founding in 1863. The carved crest top includes the Bryant College bronze seal.

## **Bryant Medallion**

The Bryant medallion is worn by the president during academic ceremonies such as Commencement, Convocation, and the bestowal of honorary degrees. One side of the medallion bears a likeness of the College seal, the other, the names of all Bryant College presidents. The formal installation of presidents is marked by the presentation of the medallion by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees to the president.

## The Bryant Seal

The Bryant seal represents the educational mission of the College and its worldwide implications. The central symbol is an ellipsoid globe with quills on each side to signify the traditional emblem of communication in business. In the center, behind the globe, is a torch symbolizing liberty, the spirit of free inquiry, academic freedom, and learning. The Archway, forming the background for the globe, torch, and quills, is a College landmark affectionately remembered by thousands of alumni. The Latin motto expresses the purpose of the College: "Educando Dirigere Mercaturam" – Education for Business Leadership.
