Honorary Degree Recipients

Beverly F. Dolan

Doctor of Business Administration

Highly regarded international busines leader and entrepreneur; former chairman of the board, president, and CEO of Textron, Inc., an \$8 billion a year aerospace, commercial products, and financial services company; co-founder in 1954 of E-Z GO, a manufacturer of golf carts, subsequently acquired by Textron; one of 20 top American executives selected to accompany President Bush to the Far East for trade talks earlier this year; an incorporator of Rhode Island Hospital; named Outstanding Citizen of Rhode Island in 1986 and Ocean State Person of the Year in 1987; graduate of the University of Georgia; recipient of an honorary degree from Roger Wiliams College.



Henry Louis Gates Jr. Doctor of Humane Letters

Illustrious scholar and educator, and celebrated author; since 1990 chair of the Afro-American Studies Department and diretor of the W. E. B. DuBois Institute for Afro-American Research at Harvard University; former member of the faculties of Duke, Cornell, and Yale Universities; recipient of many prizes and awards including the American Book Award in 1989 for "The Signifying Monkey," the MacArthur Prize, and Mellon Fellowship for study at the University of Camridge, England; prolific author and essayist; holds BA degree from Yale University and MA and PhD degrees from The Unviersity of Cambridge; awarded honorary degree by Dartmouth College in 1989.



Clarence W. Jarvis '36 Doctor of Business Administration

Highly successful industrialist and devoted friend of Bryant College; president of Jarvis Knitting Company and Conrad-Jarvis Corporation; former member of the Alumni Association Executive Board; chair of The Bryant Annual Fund from 1985 to 1987, which surpassed the \$1 million mark for the first time under his leadership; chair of the Bryant College Jubilee Club in 1988 and 1989; recipient of the Distinguished Alumni Award in 1987; inducted into the Bryant Athletic Hall of Fame in 1991; principal benefactor of the Jarvis Fitness Center at Bryant; holds BS degree from Bryant College.





Georgette P. Mosbacher Doctor of Business Administration

Prominent entrepreneur and corporate executive and devoted humanitarian; former CEO of La Prairie, Inc., a cosmetics company she founded, then sold to Beirsdorf USA, manufacturers of Nivea skin care products; continues to serve as consultant to the firm while developing new cosmetics and skin care products company; former vice president for licensing at Faberge, Inc.; board member of the Houston Grand Opera, the Susan G. Komen Foundation, MD Anderson Hospital, Child Help USA, and the Center for Strategic and International Studies; member of the Executive Committee of the American Hospital in Paris and the Statue of Liberty/Ellis Island Committee; recipient of BS degree from Indiana University.



Robert A. Mosbacher Sr.

Doctor of Business Administration

Former Cabinet member, trusted presidential advisor, and energy company executive; served as Secretary of Commerce in the Bush Administration from 1989 to 1991, resigning to become general chair of President Bush's re-election committee; distinguished government service has included National Space Council, President's Export Council, and Economic Policy Council; former chair and CEO of Mosbacher Energy Company, an independent oil and gas producer; trustee of the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars; chair of the Fund for America's Future; member of board of directors of Choate School and board of visitors of MD Anderson Hospital, University of Texas Cancer Institute; graduate of Washington & Lee University and recipient of honorary doctorate from his alma mater in 1984.



Cornelius E. Tierney '58 Doctor of Business Administration

Pre-eminent authority on public sector accounting and noted leader in his profession; a general partner at Ernst & Young and national director of the Big Six firm's public sector practice; since 1970, served as consultant and auditor for various federal agencies and other organizations, including the Small Business Administration, the US Navy, and Amtrak; former faculty member at Georgetown University; author of many books and articles on accounting, twice honored by the Association of Government Accountants as its outstanding author of the year; recipient of the Association of Government Accountants President's Award in 1988 and Andy Barr Award for eminent service in 1990; holds a BS degree from Bryant College and an MBA degree from Suffolk University.

Academic Heraldry

The history of academic dress worn today dates back to the universities of the Middle Ages. A statute of 1321 required the wearing of gowns by all scholars and clerics. Probably the warm gown and hood were practical in the unheated buildings.

Students at most American universities wore caps and gowns daily while in residence until after the Civil War. These varied in design until they were standardized by the American Intercollegiate Commission in 1895. While the academic costume code has been modified over the years, the general characteristics of the initial requirements still prevail. The uniform system of academic heraldry serves to indicate the level of degree, the field of study in which it was earned, and the institution by which it was granted. The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve and can be worn open or closed. The gown for the doctor's degree has bellshaped sleeves with black velvet facing down the front and three bars of the same across the sleeves. However, these facings and crossbars may be in the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains. At Bryant College, the president and the honorary degree recipients wear gowns especially designed and trimmed in the College color of gold.

The academic hoods are lined with the color of the university granting the degree. The border of the hood is in the color of the discipline in which the degree was earned. For example, colors associated with different subjects include: light brown (or sapphire blue) for commerce, accountancy, business; copper for economics; light blue for education; peacock blue for public administration; purple for law; and white for arts, letters, humanities.

The length of the hood varies slightly for bachelor's, master's, and doctor's degree. Today, the hood for those receiving bachelor's and master's degrees has been replaced by the mortar-board or cap with long tassels in black or in the color appropriate to the subject. It is often the tradition of the candidates for degrees to wear the tassel on the right front side before the degree is conferred and to shift it to the left when the degree is awarded.

Harriet C. Jacobs Memorial Mace

The College mace is carried at Commencement exercises and at other College celebrations. Crowned in gold, the mace has the two dominant emblems of the institution: the seal of the State of Rhode Island and the seal of Bryant College.

The President's Chair

The President's Chair, an anonymous gift to the College, is used on ceremonial occasions. It is a walnut victorian style gents chair copied from an original french design from the period of the College's founding in 1863. The carved crest top includes the Bryant College bronze seal.

Bryant Medallion

The Bryant medallion is worn by the president during academic ceremonies such as Commencement, Convocation, and the bestowal of honorary degrees. One side of the medallion bears a likeness of the College seal, the other, the names of all Bryant College presidents. The formal installation of presidents is marked by the presentation of the medallion by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees to the president.

The Bryant Seal

The Bryant seal represents the educational mission of the College and its worldwide implications. The central symbol is an ellipsoid globe with quilts on each side to signify the traditional emblem of communication in business. In the center, behind the globe, is a torch symbolizing liberty, the spirit of free inquiry, academic freedom, and learning. The Archway, forming the background for the globe, torch, and quilts, is a College landmark affectionately remembered by thousands of alumni. The Latin motto expresses the purpose of the College: "Educando Dirigere Mercaturam" - Education for Business Leadership.



If during the ceremonies the weather should become lifethreatening, the president will bring the program to an immediate conclusion. Diploma cases which remain undistributed would be made available in the MAC/Gymnasium.
