Joan Toland Bok

Doctor of Science in Business Administration

Eminent attorney and corporate executive; chair of the New England Electric System since 1984, where she has held increasingly responsible positions since 1968; previously an attorney with Ropes & Gray, Boston, Massachusetts; member of the boards of directors of Avery Dennison Corporation, the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston, the John Hancock Mutual Life Insurance Company, and Monsanto Company; serves as councilor of the American Antiquarian Society, trustee of the Boston Athenaeum, Massachusetts General Hospital corporation member; former president of Harvard University Board of Overseers and trustee of Radcliffe College; serves on visiting committees at Harvard University and Massachusetts Institute of Technology; Fellow of the American Bar Foundation; holds an AB degree from Radcliffe College and LLB from Harvard Law School; received honorary juris doctor degrees from Regis College, Nichols College, and the University of Massachusetts at Boston.



Henry C. Cisneros

Doctor of Science in Business Administration

Distinguished government official and civic leader; served four terms as mayor of San Antonio, Texas, the nation's ninth largest city; in 1986, selected Outstanding Mayor in the Nation by *City and State* magazine; received Torch of Liberty Award from Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith and Jefferson Award from American Institute of Public Service; former president of National League of Cities; trustee of the Rockefeller Foundation, Baylor College of Medicine, and Notre Dame University; board chair of the National Civic League; serves on board of the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas; member of Council on Foreign Relations and President's National Bipartisan Committee on Central America, 1983-84; currently chairman of Cisneros Asset Management Company, a national investment management firm; a Ford Foundation Scholar at Harvard University's John F. Kennedy School of Government, where he earned a master of public administration degree; also holds bachelor's and master's degrees from Texas A&M, and doctor of public administration from George Washington University; awarded honorary doctoral degrees by 14 colleges and universities.



Richard Darman

Doctor of Science in Business Administration

Cabinet member and trusted advisor to Presidents Bush, Reagan, and Ford; as director of the Office of Management and Budget, served as the Bush administration's principal negotiator of the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990; prior to joining President's Cabinet, served as a managing director of Shearson Lehman Hutton, Inc.; former deputy secretary of the US Treasury and assistant to the chief of staff; has held senior policy positions in six Cabinet departments: HEW, Defense, Justice, Commerce, State, and Treasury; Fellow of the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars; principal and director of ICF, Inc.; trustee of Bennington College and the Brookings Institution; contributing editor of *U.S. News & World Report*; member of Visiting Committee of John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University; an honors graduate of Harvard College and Harvard Business School.





Karl F. Ericson '58

Doctor of Science in Business Administration

Prominent accountant, dedicated community leader, and devoted friend of Bryant College; retired as partner in charge of audit practice at KPMG Peat Marwick in Providence in 1990; currently business consultant; past president of the Rhode Island Society of Certified Public Accountants which honored him with its Public Service Award in 1989; treasurer of the Rhode Island State Board of Accountancy and member of State Investment Commission; treasurer of the Providence Center; serves on boards of directors of Union Wadding Company, Heritage Foundation of Rhode Island, and Foundation for the Promotion of State Cultural Heritage; former president of the Rhode Island Historical Society; first alumnus to chair Board of Trustees of Bryant College, served eight years on board and continues as honorary trustee; former chair of Bryant Alumni Council, former chair of Bryant Fund; holds BS degree from Bryant College.



Yuji Ijiri

Doctor of Science in Business Administration

Noted scholar and pioneer in the field of accounting; his academic and professional writings include a score of books and more than one hundred articles; introduced momentum accounting and triple-entry bookkeeping, extending the existing accounting system logically to the third dimension; only four-time winner of the American Institute of CPAs' literature award; past president of the Accounting Researchers International Association; past president of the American Accounting Association and 1986 recipient of its Outstanding Accounting Educator award; in 1989 became the Accounting Hall of Fame's 49th and youngest inductee; a native of Japan, where he earned a bachelor's degree and CPA certificate; also holds MS from the University of Minnesota and doctorate from Carnegie Mellon; faculty member at Carnegie Mellon University since 1967, where he was promoted to Robert M. Trueblood Professor and then to University Professor, the highest honor the university can bestow on a faculty member.



Bernard G. Mondor

Doctor of Science in Business Administration

Renowned businessman and humanitarian, and patriarch of Rhode Island's only professional sports organization; retired in 1973 from highly successful business career as owner of seven corporations with a combined annual sales volume of more than \$13 million; in 1977 purchased the Pawtucket Red Sox, the bankrupt AAA International League affiliate of the Boston Red Sox, and turned the club into a highly successful organization; honored by the Commissioner of Baseball, the Baseball Writers of America, Words Unlimited, and many other groups for his outstanding contributions to sports; in 1990 awarded president's trophy by National Association of Professional Baseball Leagues; named Executive of the Year in the International League; received Local Hero Award from *New England Monthly* magazine; his altruism and philanthropy have been recognized by the Boys Club of America, Multiple Sclerosis Society, Rhode Island Association for Retarded Citizens, Boy Scouts of America, Big Brothers of Rhode Island, Easter Seal Society, American Heart Association, the Jimmy Fund, the National Hemophilia Foundation, the United Way, and the Muscular Dystrophy Association; an incorporator of public television station WSBE; holds honorary doctor of public service degree from Rhode Island College.

Richard M. Oster

Doctor of Science in Business Administration

Highly successful international business leader and entrepreneur; group managing director of Cookson Group, plc., London-based parent of Cookson America, a manufacturer of specialty industrial materials with annual sales in excess of \$3 billion; joined Cookson in 1979, when the British firm purchased his family's brass plating business, the A. J. Oster Company; as president of Cookson America, transformed the dilapidated former Union Train Station into the company's corporate headquarters and made it the showpiece of downtown Providence; chairs the Rhode Island Convention Center Authority and Commission 1992; trustee of the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith, Roger Williams College, and the University of Rhode Island Foundation; serves on boards of the Meeting Street School, Rhode Island Chapter of the National Association of Christians and Jews, Big Brothers of Rhode Island, and the Rhode Island Jewish Federation; received BS degree from the University of Rhode Island and attended Suffolk Law School; a Fellow of Brandeis University, holds honorary degrees from the University of Rhode Island, Rhode Island College, and New England Institute of Technology.

Academic Heraldry

The history of academic dress worn today dates back to the universities of the Middle Ages. A statute of 1321 required the wearing of gowns by all scholars and clerics. Probably the warm gown and hood were practical in the unheated buildings.

Students at most American universities wore caps and gowns daily while in residence until after the Civil War. These varied in design until they were standardized by the American Intercollegiate Commission in 1895. While the academic costume code has been modified over the years, the general characteristics of the initial requirements still prevail. The uniform system of academic heraldry serves to indicate the level of degree, the field of study in which it was earned, and the institution by which it was granted. The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve and can be worn open or closed. The gown for the doctor's degree has bellshaped sleeves with black velvet facing down the front and three bars of the same across the sleeves. However, these facings and crossbars may be in the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains. At Bryant College, the president and the honorary degree recipients wear gowns especially designed and trimmed in the College color of gold.

The academic hoods are lined with the color of the university granting the degree. The border of the hood is in the color of the discipline in which the degree was earned. For example, colors associated with different subjects include: light brown (or sapphire blue) for commerce, accountancy, business; copper for economics; light blue for education; peacock blue for public administration; purple for law; and white for arts, letters, humanities.

The length of the hood varies slightly for bachelor's and master's, and doctor's degree. Today, the hood for those receiving bachelor's and master's degrees has been replaced by the mortar-board or cap with long tassels in black or in the color appropriate to the subject. It is often the tradition of the candidates for degrees to wear the tassel on the right front side before the degree is conferred and to shift it to the left when the degree is awarded.

Harriet C. Jacobs Memorial Mace

The College mace is carried at Commencement exercises and at other College celebrations. Crowned in gold, the mace has the two dominant emblems of the institution: the seal of the State of Rhode Island and the seal of Bryant College.

The Bryant Seal

The Bryant seal represents the educational mission of the College and its worldwide implications. The central symbol is an ellipsoid globe with quills on each side to signify the traditional emblem of communication in business. In the center, behind the globe, is a torch symbolizing liberty, the spirit of free inquiry, academic freedom, and learning. The Archway, forming the background for the globe, torch, and quills, is a College landmark affectionately remembered by thousands of alumni. The Latin motto expresses the purpose of the College: “Educando Dirigere Mercaturam” — Education for Business Leadership.
