Honorary Degree Recipients

Alan Greenspan Doctor of Science in Business Administration

Chairman of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve Board, and the reserve system's Federal Open Market Committee, its principal monetary policy-making body; former chairman and president of Townsend-Greenspan & Co., Inc., an economic consulting firm in New York City; former chairman of the President's Council of Economic Advisers; served as a member of TIME magazine's board of economists, a senior adviser to the Brookings Panel on Economic Activity, and a consultant to the Congressional Budget Office; corporate directorships he has held include Alcoa; Capital Cities/ABC; General Foods; Mobil; Morgan Guaranty Trust, and The Rand Corporation; holds B.S., M.A., and Ph.D. degrees in economics from New York University.

Robert M. Solow Doctor of Science in Business Administration

Won the 1987 Nobel Memorial Prize in Economic Science for seminal contributions to the theory of economic growth; Institute Professor (a rank of special distinction) and professor of economics at Massachusetts Institute of Technology; recognized as an outstanding economic theorist; professor at MIT since 1950; Institute Professor since 1973; recipient of numerous awards and honors; author or co-author of four books and more than 100 papers for professional journals; senior economist on President Kennedy's Council of Economic Advisors; served on two commissions for President Johnson; former director and chairman of the board of the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston; holds B.A., M.A. and Ph.D. degrees in economics from Harvard University.

John Hope Franklin Doctor of Humanities

One of America's most honored historians; James B. Duke Professor Emeritus of History at Duke University; teaches also at the Duke School of Law; has taught at the University of Chicago, Brooklyn College, Howard University, North Carolina College, St. Augustine's College, and Fisk University; visiting professor at Cambridge; Harvard; Cornell; the Universities of Wisconsin, California-Berkeley, and Hawaii, and universities in Australia and New Zealand; author or editor of 18 books and more than 100 papers and articles; leader in a host of historical, humanities, and nonprofit associations; former Fisk University trustee; holds an A.B. degree from Fisk and M.A. and Ph.D. degrees from Harvard.

Norman Sarkisian '53 Doctor of Science in Business Administration

President and owner of The Beacon Group, a holding company near Hartford, Connecticut, which includes Beacon Industries, Inc., Beacon Winch Company, Smyth Manufacturing Company, Smyth-Horne Ltd., of London, and Beacon Racing Stables, of Ocala, FL; 1953 Bryant graduate; long-time supporter of Bryant; established Bryant's first academic chair: The Norman Sarkisian Chair in Business Economics; Bryant Trustee and chair of development committee; has served as president of the board of trustees of Hartford Seminary regent for the University of Hartford, trustee for Hartford Seminary and the Bradley Air Museum, corporator for Hartford Hospital, and a member of Connecticut Bank & Trust Company's business and economic advisory board.

William Olliver Bailey Doctor of Science in Business Administration

Vice chairman of Aetna Life & Casualty, the nation's largest publicly owned insurance and financial services organization, and chairman and chief executive officer of Municipal Bond Investors Assurance, Inc., the nation's largest municipal bond insurer; insurance industry leader and spokesman before legislative bodies for many years; has served as chairman of the American Insurance Association, the Health Insurance Association of America, and the Property Casualty Insurance Council; member of the boards of Terra Nova Insurance Company Ltd, Insilco Corporation, and Northeast Utilities; director of the University of Connecticut Foundation and the Hartford Courant Foundation; holds a bachelor's degree from Dartmouth and a master's degree from the Wharton School of Finance at the University of Pennsylvania.

Academic Heraldry

The history of academic dress worn today dates back to the universities of the Middle Ages. A statute of 1321 required the wearing of gowns by all scholars and clerics. Probably the warm gown and hood were practical in the unheated buildings.

Students at most American universities wore caps and gowns daily while in residence until after the Civil War. These varied in design until they were standardized by the American Intercollegiate Commission in 1895. While the academic costume code has been modified over the years, the general characteristics of the initial requirements still prevail. The uniform system of academic heraldry serves to indicate the level of degree, the field of study in which it was earned, and the institution by which it was granted. The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve and can be worn open or closed. The gown for the doctor's degree has bell-shaped sleeves with black velvet facing down the front and three bars of the same across the sleeves. However, these facings and crossbars may be in the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains. At Bryant College, the president and the honorary degree recipients wear gowns especially designed and trimmed in the College color of gold.

The academic hoods are lined with the color of the university granting the degree. The border of the hood is in the color of the discipline in which the degree was earned. For example, colors associated with different subjects include: light brown (or sapphire blue) for commerce, accountancy, business; copper for economics; light blue for education; peacock blue for public administration; purple for law; and white for arts, letters, humanities.

The length of the hood varies slightly for bachelor's, and master's and doctor's degree. Today, the hood for those receiving bachelor's and master's degrees has been replaced by the mortar-board or cap with long tassels in black or in the color appropriate to the subject. It is often the tradition of the candidates for degrees to wear the tassel on the right front side before the degree is conferred and to shift it to the left when the degree is awarded.

Harriet C. Jacobs Memorial Mace

The College mace is carried at Commencement exercises and at other College celebrations. Crowned in gold, the mace has the two dominant emblems of the institution: the seal of the State of Rhode Island and the seal of Bryant College.

The Bryant seal represents the educational mission of the College and its worldwide implications. The central symbol is an ellipsoid globe with quills on each side to signify the traditional emblem of communication in business. In the center, behind the globe, is a torch symbolizing liberty, the spirit of free inquiry, academic freedom, and learning. The Archway, forming the background for the globe, torch, and quills, is a College landmark affectionately remembered by thousands of alumni. The Latin motto expresses the purpose of the College: "Educando Dirigere Mercaturam" – Education for Business Leadership.
