Attention - All Students

Annually, Bryant College informs students of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974. This Act, with which the institution intends to comply fully, was designated to protect the privacy of education records, to establish the right of students to inspect and review their education records, and to provide guidelines for the correction of inaccurate or misleading data through informal and formal hearings. Students also have the right to file complaints with The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act Office (FERPA) concerning

alleged failures by the institution to comply with the Act.

Local policy explains in detail the procedures to be used by the institution for compliance with the provisions of the Act. Copies of the policy can be found in the following offices: Registrar, Student Affairs, Public Affairs and Bursar. The policy is also printed in the Student Handbook.

Questions concerning the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act may be referred to the Registrar's Office.

Among their vast array of programs and enterprises offered to the Bryant Community, two of the major services are the Boutique Shoppe, located in the Unistructure, and the Country Comfort, a restored barn converted into a deli-grinder shop and pub which has been recently expanded to accommodate more than 200 people. Among the multitude of other services offered by Brycol are class ring sales, newspaper

subscriptions, refrigerator rentals, mixology course, alumni mirrors and an upcoming birthday cake delivery service.

Because of all these services Brycol provides, they were able to employ over thirty students in part-time positions during the last academic year with a larger staff expected this year. These student positions ranged from accounting to maintenance and from bartending to secretarial.

Student representatives from all corners of the Bryant community comprise the 20 member Board of Directors. Headed by an Executive Committee consisting of a president, executive director, vice president, treasurer, secretary, and employee representative, all working in conjunction with the Board of

Directors, are involved in making every phase of the operation run smoothly.
