A cordial welcome to relatives, friends, students, faculty, and alumni who gather here today to celebrate Bryant College's One Hundred and Eleventh Commencement.

Academic Heraldry

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn today in these Commencement Exercises are patterned after the attire of monks and students in the Middle Ages. Those who have earned the bachelor's degree wear a gown and a semistiff yoke, long pleated front, intricate shirring across the shoulders and back, which is also distinguished by long, pointed sleeves. The holder of a master's degree wears a similar gown, with long or short oblong sleeves which hang down in the traditional manner and open at the wrist. Those possessing the doctor's degree wear gowns with broad velvet panels down the front and three velvet bars on the full, round, open sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the field of learning represented by the degree.

Most of the colors and meanings of the costumes are found in the hoods. These are silk-lined with the color or colors of the institution conferring the degree. The border of the hood is velvet and its color signifies the field of learning to which the degree pertains.

Honorary Degrees



DOCTOR OF SCIENCE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

THE RIGHT REVEREND JOHN MELVILLE BURGESS, D.D.

Bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of Massachusetts

Born in Grand Rapids, Michigan, Bishop Burgess received his undergraduate and graduate degrees from the University of Michigan and his Bachelor of Divinity degree from the Episcopal Theological School, Cambridge, Massachusetts. He began his ministry at St. Philip's Church in Grand Rapids, Michigan and later became Vicar of the Mission of St. Simon of Cyrene, Lincoln Heights, Ohio. After five years as Chaplain to Episcopal students at Howard University in Washington, D.C., he was appointed Canon of the Washington Cathedral. Later he became Archdeacon of Boston and Superintendent of the Episcopal City Mission until his consecration as Suffragan Bishop and subsequent election as Bishop Coadjutor of the Diocese of Massachusetts. He assumed the office of Bishop of the Diocese in 1970. Bishop Burgess has represented the Episcopal church twice as delegate to the World Council of Churches in India. He is on the General Board of the National Council of Churches and the Massachusetts Civil Liberties Union. A director of the Boston YMCA, he is also a trustee of the Deaconess Hospital; St. Augustine's College, Raleigh, North Carolina; Berkeley Divinity School, New Haven, Connecticut; Groton School, Groton, Massachusetts; St. Mark's School, Southboro, Massachusetts; the Church Pension Fund, and the National Executive Council of the Episcopal Church.



DOCTOR OF SCIENCE IN PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

HELENE S. MARKOFF

Director, Federal Women's Program, U.S. Civil Service Commission

A native of Rhode Island, Ms. Markoff received her degree from Bryant College in 1949, and completed advance studies at the University of Rhode Island. Her Federal career spanned a 20-year period with the Department of the Navy where she served at field installation and headquarters level in Rhode Island, Washington, D.C., Spain and Morocco. Appointed to her present position in May of 1970, she has the overall responsibility for providing guidance and direction to Federal agencies in advancing the status and employment of women. She earned the Superior Accomplishment Award in 1965 for conducting a wage survey in Spain. She also received the Navy Civilian Meritorious Award for developing the Navy Equal Employment Opportunity Program. In 1971, she was nominated for the Federal Woman's Award. An Advisory Member of Washington Opportunities for Women, Ms. Markoff is a member of the American Society of Public Administration, the American Academy of Political and Social Sciences, and the Washington Forum.

DOCTOR OF SCIENCE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

FREDERICK C. TANNER

Chairman of the Board, Federal Products Corporation

Mr. Tanner holds an engineering degree from Pratt Institute in New York, of which he is presently a trustee. He served as Chairman of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers. Largely responsible for the growth of the Federal Products Company, manufacturers of precision instruments, he became its president while simultaneously placing his knowledge of industry and finance at the service of many local, state and national institutions. He is a member of the Board of Directors of Bryant College. From 1955 to 1959, he served as Vice Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Rhode Island colleges. A past president of the Providence Chamber of Commerce and the Providence Rotary Club, he was also a member of the National Committee of the Chamber of Commerce of the United States and on the Industrial Advisory Committee of the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston; and advisor to the Nuclear Energy Committee of the National Association of Manufacturers and director of the New England Electric System. He is on the Board of Directors of the Citizens Trust Company, the Bostitch Company, the Providence Journal and the Providence Gravure Company. He also serves as Director of the United Fund and Junior Achievement, and vice-president of Roger Williams Hospital.



DOCTOR OF LETTERS

IRVING R. LEVINE

National Broadcasting Company News Correspondent

A native of Pawtucket, Rhode Island, Irving R. Levine was graduated Phi Beta Kappa from Brown University and received his master's degree from the Columbia Graduate School of Journalism. He began his journalism career with the Providence Journal-Bulletin; his career as a foreign correspondent began in Vienna as bureau chief for International News Service. News events have taken him all over the world. Prior to his current assignment as Economic Affairs Correspondent in Washington, D.C., Mr. Levine was based as NBC News Correspondent for eleven years in Rome, four years in Moscow, two years in Tokyo and a year in London. He is a regular feature of "Today" and NBC "Nightly News", panelist on "Meet the Press" and other NBC Specials. The author of "Main Street USSR", "Main Street Italy", "The New Worker in Soviet Russia" and "Travel Guide to Russia", he is also a contributor of articles to magazines and frequent lecturer at universities. His journalism awards include the Overseas Press Club Honor for "the most outstanding radio and TV reporting from abroad", a "Headliner's Award" and an Emmy citation. In 1963, he was named to the Columbia Graduate School of Journalism's list of outstanding graduates. Mr. Levine served as an officer in the Signal Corps in World War II. In 1972, he was named to the Rhode Island Heritage Hall of Fame.

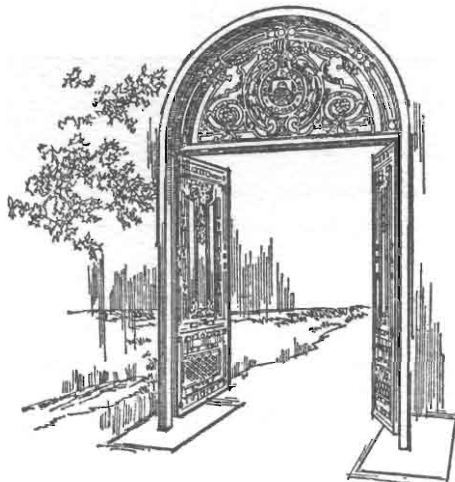
