# Honorary Degrees

## DOCTOR OF SCIENCE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION BARBARA HACKMAN FRANKLIN

Commissioner, United States Consumer Products Safety Commission

Preceding this recent appointment, Mrs. Franklin was appointed by the President to recruit women for top-level, policy-making positions in the Federal government. She came to the White House in 1971 from the First National City Bank in New York City, where she was an Assistant Vice President. She joined Citibank in 1961 as Projects Manager in the Corporate Planning Department. Prior to this, she was with the Singer Company in New York where she became Manager of Environmental Analysis. A graduate of the Pennsylvania State University, she was chosen outstanding senior woman and in 1964 was one of the first women to receive an MBA from the Harvard Graduate School of Business Administration. She is a native of Lancaster, Pennsylvania, and was a member of the Business Research Advisory Council to the Bureau of Labor Statistics and the North American Society for Corporate Planning. She is listed in Who's Who of American Women and Outstanding Young Women of America.

# Doctor of Science in Business Administration SAMUEL ROSEN

President, School House Candy Corporation

A native of Providence, Rhode Island, Samuel Rosen was educated in its public schools and began his successful business career with a small candy-jobbing operation. This business expanded to supply national chain stores and became known as the School House Candy Company. The ERCO Corporation, the Rosbro Plastics Company, the Cellophane Products Corporation, the Lonsdale Realty Company, the International Realty Company, the Globe Assembly Company, the American Chemical Works Company, all these came under his management. Mr. Rosen, a former President of Temple Emanu-El, is currently honorary president. He established the Gertrude J. Rosen Memorial Fund for retarded children and the elderly in memory of his deceased wife. He is a board member of the Jewish Theological Seminary, Honorary Director of the Hebrew Free Loan Association, on the Board of Directors of the Jewish Federation of R. I. and the Endowment Committee of U.R.I. He has established scholarships at Brandeis University and the Jewish Theological Seminary.

## DOCTOR OF SCIENCE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION ARTACKY BERBERIAN President, Manufacturers Supply Company

Born in Constantinople, Turkey, Mr. Berberian is believed to be the first student of Armenian parentage to attend Classical High School in Providence, and was probably the first Armenian student to enroll at Bryant College. A member of the Class of 1909, he has been an active and loyal alumnus, holding many committee responsibilities in the Alumni Association. He is presently the Bryant College Alumni Association's liaison member to the "Old Guard" (graduates out of Bryant fifty or more years). An active member of Rotary International, he was honored as Rotarian of the Year by the Miami Beach Rotary Club in April, 1973. He is a member of the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, Lodge #14; Grand Legislative Committee Chairman of the United Commercial Travelers of America; a director of the Manufacturing Jewelers Sales Association, Inc., and was a member of the Building Committee of St. Vartanantz Armenian Apostolic Church in Providence.

# DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS THOMAS H. ROBERTS

Chief Justice, Supreme Court of Rhode Island

Born in Providence, Rhode Island, Chief Justice Roberts was educated in its public schools, La Salle Academy, Fordham University, Boston University School of Law (LL.D), and at Suffolk University (S.J.D.). After being admitted to the Rhode Island Bar, he became Deputy Recorder of Deeds for the city of Providence and among many important appointments became General Counsel for the U.S. War Claims Commission, Washington, D.C.; U.S. District Judge for the District of Puerto Rico. In 1951, he became Associate Justice of the Superior Court of R. I. and in 1956 held this same position with the R. I. Supreme Court. He has been Chief Justice of the R. I. Supreme Court since January 7, 1966. He is a member of the Institute of Judicial Administration, the Conference of Chief Justices, Board of Visitors of Boston University Law School, Phi Alpha Delta, and the Papal Order, Knights of St. Gregory.
