TODAY MARKS THE CULMINATION OF BRYANT'S 153RD ACADEMIC YEAR. IT IS AN EXHILARATING TIME TO BE PART OF THIS SCHOLARLY COMMUNITY THAT LAYS CLAIM TO A RICH HISTORY AND A FUTURE BRIMMING WITH PROMISE.

In 1863, Civil War veterans used their mustering-out pay to enroll at Bryant and gain the skills needed to enter the workforce. Over the years, the value of a Bryant education has continued to climb: 99 percent of the Class of 2015 was employed or enrolled in graduate school within six months of graduation. That stellar statistic reflects the collaborative relationship between high-achieving students, accomplished and caring faculty, dedicated staff, and successful alumni who share their time and expertise.

Bryant has always been innovative and evolved to meet the changing needs of its students, transitioning from a college to a university a dozen years ago and integrating business disciplines with the liberal arts.

Last May, the University launched the largest and most transformative facilities initiative since Bryant's move from Providence to Smithfield 45 years ago. Resources from our historical capital campaign, *Expanding the World of Opportunity: The Campaign for Bryant's Bold Future*, are steadily advancing our progress toward the ambitious goals of the University's Vision 20/20 strategic plan.

A major component of a Bryant education is providing students and faculty with broad global perspectives through its curriculum, study abroad opportunities, and initiatives offered through the U.S.-China Institute and Confucius Institute. For more than a decade, these Institutes, led by Bryant's Vice President for International Affairs Hong Yang, Ph.D., have facilitated academic, business, and cultural exchanges with institutions and officials in China.

The results have been profound. In September 2015, we welcomed our first class at Bryant Zhuhai. Located in Guangdong Province, China, this unique program with Beijing Institute of Technology Zhuhai will educate both Chinese and U.S. students. The academic program has been designed to mirror Bryant's nationally recognized curriculum vigor and quality of faculty and is taught in English. Graduating students will receive a Bryant University degree.

Bryant Zhuhai is the first and only American university with a presence in Zhuhai, the first university to establish a partnership with a private institution in China, and the only U.S.-China joint four-year undergraduate business degree program in China. 美国布莱恩特大学, 诚挚欢迎您来访!

历史的车轮回转到1863年,当时参加过美国南北战争的老兵用他们的退 伍金支付学费并在布莱恩特大学开始学习进入职场所需的工作技能。从那刻 起,布莱恩特大学教育的价值便不断攀升:99%的布莱恩特大学2015届毕业 生在毕业后的六个月内找到工作或继续进入研究生院深造。能够取得如此瞩 目的成绩,源于布莱恩特这个大家庭中刻苦努力的学子、专业热诚的教授、 细致负责的职员和优秀出色的校友,源于所有"布大人"共同努力合作并奉献 他们的时间和专业精神。

布莱恩特大学不断创新,始终关注学生对于教育需求的变化。学校在12年 前由学院模式发展成为如今的综合性私立大学,并实现了文理与商科完美结 合的学术课程体系。

4 5 年前, 布莱恩特大学由普罗维登斯(罗德岛州首府)迁至如今位于史密 斯菲尔德的新校区。2 0 1 5 年 5 月, 学校宣布并启动迁校后最大规模且最 具变革性的校园发展计划。以"拓展全球机遇, 共建璀璨未来"为主题的学校 集资工程所提供的资源持续推动并提升着整体办学质量, 从而最终实现学校 的"Vision 20/20战略发展计划"各项宏伟目标。

布莱恩特大学教育体系的一个核心部分是通过其特色课程设置、海外留学项 目以及学校美中研究所和孔子学院的资源和项目,培养在校学生及教职人员 具备全球化视野和国际化经验。十几年来,由学校国际事务副校长杨洪博士 带领的部门团队,极大发展并促进了布莱恩特大学与中国高等院校、工商团 体和政府机构在学术、商贸、文化等方面的合作,成果显著。

2015年9月,布莱恩特大学与北京理工大学珠海学院的合作办学项目在 其位于中国广东省珠海市的校园正式成立"布莱恩特学院",并迎来了第一届 入学新生。该中外合作办学项目为中美两国学生提供优质特色的高等教育资 源,课程设置依托布莱恩特大学高规格学术标准和内容,由优秀专业教授全 程英语授课。毕业生将获得由布莱恩特大学授予的美方学位证书。

布莱恩特大学是在珠海市开办合作办学项目的第一所且唯一一所美国大学, 是第一所与中国私立大学建立合作伙伴关系的美国大学,也是第一所在中国 开设四年制中美合作本科商学学位项目的大学。

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS



Clayton M. Christensen

HONORARY DOCTOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

Clayton M. Christensen, D.B.A., the Kim B. Clark Professor of Business Administration at the Harvard Business School, who is regarded as one of the world's top experts on innovation and growth, will deliver the keynote address to graduating seniors and their guests.

Christensen is the best-selling author of 10 books, with an 11th to be published this fall. They include *The Innovator's Dilemma*, named one of the six most important books about business ever written, and the groundbreaking, *How Will You Measure Your Life?* He is the recipient of numerous awards for his work, and he has been featured twice on the cover of *Forbes Magazine*. In 2011, in a poll of thousands of executives, consultants, and business school professors, he was named the most influential business thinker in the world.

Christensen has served as a director of many companies, and has advised the executives of scores of the world's major corporations. These companies generate tens of billions of dollars in revenue annually from product and service innovations that were inspired by his research.

An experienced entrepreneur, Christensen has started four successful companies. Prior to joining the Harvard Business School faculty, he and three MIT professors founded CPS Technologies, which has become a leading developer and manufacturer of products from high-technology materials. In 2000, he founded Innosight, a consulting firm that uses his theories of innovation to help companies create new growth businesses. In 2007, he founded Rose Park Advisors, a firm that identifies and invests in disruptive companies. He also founded the Christensen Institute, a non-profit think tank whose mission is to apply his theories to societal problems such as health care and education.

Christensen holds a B.A. with highest honors in economics from Brigham Young University and an M.Phil. in applied econometrics from Oxford University, where he studied as a Rhodes Scholar. He received an MBA with High Distinction from the Harvard Business School, graduating as a George F. Baker Scholar. In 1982, he was named a White House Fellow, and served as assistant to U.S. Transportation Secretaries Drew Lewis and Elizabeth Dole. He was awarded a DBA from the Harvard Business School in 1992, at which time he became a faculty member there. Christensen, who speaks fluent Korean, holds five honorary doctorates and an honorary chaired professorship at the Tsinghua University in Taiwan. He has served with the Boy Scouts of America for more than 25 years.

Tustice Maureen McKenna Goldberg

HONORARY DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS

Rhode Island Supreme Court Senior Associate Justice Maureen McKenna Goldberg has devoted her career to public service in the state. She was appointed to the Rhode Island Superior Court on July 9, 1990, and to the Rhode Island Supreme Court on May 30, 1997, the third woman in Rhode Island history to achieve that position on the state's highest court.

Justice Goldberg enrolled at Providence College as a member of the first class that included women. After graduating with honors from Providence College in 1973 and Suffolk University School of Law in 1978, she began her professional career as a prosecutor in the Rhode Island Office of Attorney General, rising to the rank of administrator of the criminal division. In 1984, she entered private practice at Goldberg Law Offices but continued serving the state and its municipalities, frequently on a pro bono basis, until her appointment to the Superior Court in 1990.

Determined to be a fair-minded judge, Justice Goldberg is committed to justice and the rule of law, every day, one case at a time. As a justice of the Superior and Supreme Courts, she has worked for the advancement of women at the bar, on the bench, and in the workplace. In addition to mentoring many young women, she has offered students the opportunity to advance educationally and professionally through internships and clerkships. She passionately believes in broadening higher education opportunities for all.

Justice Goldberg holds active memberships in local, state, and national bar associations and is dedicated to the improvement of the law and the delivery of legal services. She also has devoted her time as a board member to philanthropic, educational, and rehabilitative institutions in Rhode Island. She served as Chair of the Board of Trustees of her alma mater, St. Mary Academy – Bay View, and was on the Board of Directors of The Rhode Island Foundation from 2003 to 2012. She is currently a member of the Board of Directors of Phoenix Houses of New England.

HONORARY DOCTOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION



Taoguang "TG" Wang, Ph.D., is Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Beijing Institute of Technology Zhuhai, located in Guangdong Province, China. He was appointed to this position in 2014 and previously held the position of Chairman of the Board from 2009 to 2013.

Prior to his 2014 appointment at Beijing Institute of Technology Zhuhai, Wang held leadership positions in the business sector and on a number of boards both in Hong Kong and mainland China. From 2013 to 2014, he was Chairman of the Board of Directors of Shenzhen Everbright Strategic Investment Corporation Limited. From 2008 to 2010, he was the Executive Director of Beijing Enterprise Water Group Limited, which is listed on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange. From 2006 to 2010, he was Deputy Chairman of the Board of Directors of ZKC Environmental Protection Investment Group Limited.

He held leadership roles with the China Everbright Real Estate Group, the Shanghai FOSUN Group and Tebon Securities Limited, China Everbright Securities Limited, China Everbright Holding Limited Corporation, and China Everbright Investment and Asset Management Corporation Limited.

Wang received a Bachelor of Laws and Master of Laws in 1986 and 1989 from Peking University and a Master's degree in Finance from Bowling Green State University in 1994. He earned a Ph.D. in Economics from Peking University in 1999 under the supervision of Professor Li Yining, China's renowned economist. Wang received postdoctoral training at Harvard University in 1999.

In September 2015, Bryant University welcomed its historic first entering class of 160 Chinese students at Bryant Zhuhai. Wang has been an invaluable partner as Bryant created this unique program in collaboration with the Beijing Institute of Technology Zhuhai to educate both Chinese and U.S. students, providing them with a global perspective and education that is essential for success in today's interconnected world.

ACADEMIC HONORS

Special recognition is accorded those who show distinction in academic achievement. Honors may be awarded on the basis of cumulative averages, as follows: *Cum Laude* (with honors – GPA of 3.30), *Magna Cum Laude* (with high honors – GPA of 3.55), and *Summa Cum Laude* (with highest honors – GPA of 3.80). Students must have completed sixty (60) semester hours of coursework at Bryant University to be eligible for honors.

hp HONORS PROGRAM

The Bryant University Honors Program provides highly qualified and motivated students with special opportunities to challenge themselves while developing their intellectual abilities and talents through an interdisciplinary curriculum. In order to be considered Honors Program graduates, students must successfully complete a rigorous curriculum of eight honors-level courses, including an Honors Senior Capstone Project. In addition, each student needs to earn a minimum overall GPA of 3.4 and a minimum Honors GPA of 3.2 in his or her coursework.

HONOR SOCIETIES

△ Alpha Kappa Delta – The International Sociology Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, students must have at least junior-year standing, an overall GPA and a sociology GPA of at least 3.0, be in the top 35 percent of their class, and have completed a minimum of four courses in sociology.

ß Beta Gamma Sigma – International Honor Society

This is the highest national recognition a student can receive in an undergraduate program in a business or management program accredited by AACSB International – The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business. Members must have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.5 and rank in the upper 10 percent of the second-semester junior class, upper 10 percent of the senior class, or top 20 percent of the graduating master's class.

E Kappa Mu Epsilon – Mathematics Specialized Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, students must have completed at least three college semesters and rank in the upper 35 percent of their class. In addition, they must have completed at least three courses in mathematics, including at least one semester of calculus, and attained an average of "B" or better in all mathematics courses.

Λ Lambda Pi Eta – Communication Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, a student must have completed at least 12 hours of communication courses, have a GPA of at least 3.25, and be in the upper 35 percent of the graduating class.

T Mu Kappa Tau – National Marketing Honor Society

In order to qualify for membership, a student must be a junior or a senior marketing major or business concentrator with a marketing minor, and have a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher.

μ Mu Sigma Rho – National Statistics Honorary Society

To be eligible for induction, a student must be a junior or senior, have completed eight semester hours of statistics courses (of which at least five semester hours must be at the junior level or higher), have a 3.25 GPA in all statistics courses, and be in the top third of the class in all coursework.

O Omicron Delta Epsilon – National Economics Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, a student must have chosen economics for his or her major field of concentration, have attained a cumulative average of 3.0 or higher in a minimum of four economics courses, and have received the recommendation of the economics department.

K Omicron Delta Kappa – National Leadership Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, a student must be a junior or senior recognized for excellence in academics (top 35 percent of the class), athletics, community service, mass media, or the performing arts. All members are nominated by current members of the society.

Φ Phi Alpha Theta – The National History Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, a student must earn a minimum GPA of 3.1 in at least 12 semester hours in history and an overall GPA of 3.0, and must also be in the top 35 percent of his or her class.

π Pi Sigma Alpha – The National Political Science Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, students must have completed a minimum of 12 semester hours of political science courses with a minimum GPA of 3.3, as well as an overall minimum GPA of 3.3.

I Phi Sigma Iota – International Foreign Language Honor Society

To be eligible for membership, a student must be pursuing a major, minor, or concentration in one of the languages offered at Bryant (Chinese, French, Italian or Spanish), have completed at least one course at the 300 level (305 or above) and 45 semester hours, have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 overall and a minimum grade point average of 3.5 in his or her language courses, and rank in the top 35 percent of his or her class.

Ψ Psi Chi – The International Honor Society in Psychology

To be eligible for membership, students must have an overall GPA that is in the top 35 percent of their class, an overall grade point average of at least 3.0, and a cumulative average that is at least 3.0 in their psychology courses. Membership is limited to Applied Psychology majors who are at least juniors and have taken a minimum of nine hours of psychology.

Σ Sigma Tau Delta – International English Honor Society

To be eligible for membership in the Alpha Tau Rho Chapter of Sigma Tau Delta, a student must have completed a minimum of two college courses in English language or literature beyond the usual requirements in freshman English. The candidate must have a minimum of a "B" or equivalent average in English and in general scholarship, must rank at least in the top 35 percent of her/his class, and must have completed at least three semesters or five quarters of college coursework.

The University Mace is carried at Commencement exercises and at other University celebrations. Crowned in gold, the mace has two dominant emblems: the seal of the State of Rhode Island and the seal of Bryant University.

THE PRESIDENT'S CHAIR

The President's Chair, a gift to the University from Priscilla Angelo and her husband, John Eng-Wong, is used on ceremonial occasions. It is a Victorian-style gent's chair rendered in walnut and copied from an original French design from the period of the University's founding in 1863. The carved crest top includes the Bryant University bronze seal.

BRYANT MEDALLION

The Bryant Medallion is worn by the president during academic ceremonies such as Commencement, Convocation, and the bestowing of honorary degrees. One side of the medallion bears a likeness of the University seal, the other, the names of all Bryant University presidents. The formal installation of a president is marked by the presentation of the medallion to the president by the chair of the Board of Trustees.

THE BRYANT SEAL

The Bryant Seal represents the educational mission of the University and its worldwide implications. The central symbol is an ellipsoid globe with quills on each side to signify the traditional emblem of communication in business. In the center, behind the globe, is a torch symbolizing liberty, the spirit of free inquiry, academic freedom, and learning. The Archway, forming the background for the globe, torch, and quills, is a University landmark affectionately remembered by thousands of alumni. The Latin motto expresses the purpose of the University: "Cognitio. Virtus. Successus." – Knowledge. Character. Success.

ALUMNI CHARGE

Today, as you celebrate your graduation from Bryant University, you find yourself saying goodbye to the classmates, faculty, and staff with whom you have formed close friendships over these last few years. ACADEMIC HERALDRY

The history of academic dress worn today dates back to the universities of the Middle Ages. A statute in 1321 required the wearing of gowns by all scholars and clerics. Probably, the warm gown and hood were practical in the unheated buildings.

Students at most American universities wore caps and gowns daily while in residence until after the Civil War. These varied in design until they were standardized by the American Intercollegiate Commission in 1895. While the academic costume code has been modified over the years, the general characteristics of the initial requirements still prevail. The uniform system of academic heraldry serves to indicate the level of degree, the field of study in which it was earned, and the institution by which it was granted.

The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve and can be worn open or closed. The gown for the doctoral degree has bell-shaped sleeves with black velvet facing down the front and three bars of the same across the sleeves. However, these facings and crossbars may be in the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains.

The academic hoods are lined with the color of the university granting the degree. The length of the hood varies slightly for bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees. It is often traditional for the candidates for degrees to wear the mortarboard tassel on the right front side before the degree is conferred and to shift it to the left when the degree is awarded.

At Bryant University, the president, trustees, and honorary degree recipients wear specially-designed gold robes trimmed with black, representative of the University's colors.
