MORRIS (12/10/75) -- A new philosophical journal entitled <u>Midwest Studies in Philosophy</u> has been founded at the University of Minnesota, Morris under the aegis of the UMM philosophy discipline.

The new publication is scheduled to appear in February of each year, according to philosophy discipline coordinator Ted Uehling, who is one of the three editors.

The first volume consists of the major papers delivered at the first annual Midwest Philosophy Colloquium accompanied by invited discussion papers from major philosophers.

The Colloquium, now in its second year, was inaugurated on the Morris campus in 1974.

Succeeding volumes will follow the same pattern, Uehling said, and will include space for unsolicited responses to the previous volume.

The editors have entitled Volume I "Studies in the History of Philosophy," Volume II, "Studies in the Philosophy of Language," and Volume III as "Studies in Ethical Theory."

The editors, in addition to Uehling, are Peter A. French and Howard K. Wettstein.

"The response by philosophers asked to contribute both to the Colloquium and to the journal has been overwhelmingly positive," said Uehling.

"We are most excited," he added, "about the prospect of UMM being the home of what will be, by all indications, an important philosophical journal."
