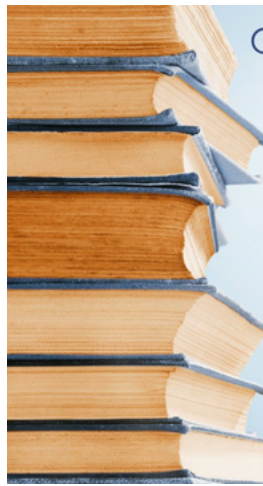
This event is free and only for residents. Waste from schools & businesses, including farms will NOT be accepted without prior approval.

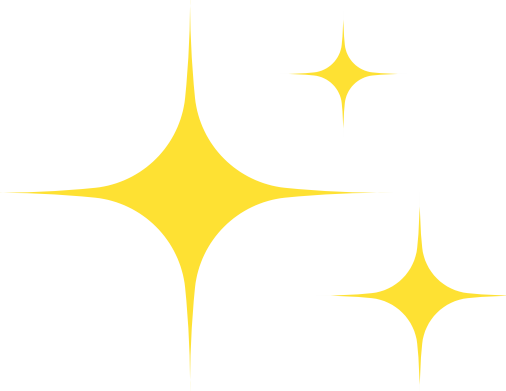
