Must quit now as Shelly, Coleen's mother has come in.

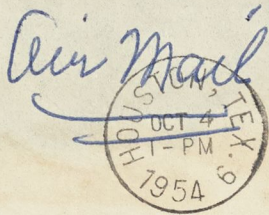
Know you are having a good time. Tell Jimmy hello.
