But all will undergird the necessities of the Church willingly, without grudge, knowing that "The Lord loveth a cheerful giver."

Paul said to the Church folks of Thessalonica, "I give thanks to God for your work of faith
and labor of love and stedfastness of hope in
our Lord Jesus Christ." Your Pastor humbly
repeats these words. And he urges you "not to
be weary in well-doing", for "God the Father
shall bless you with every spiritual blessing."
