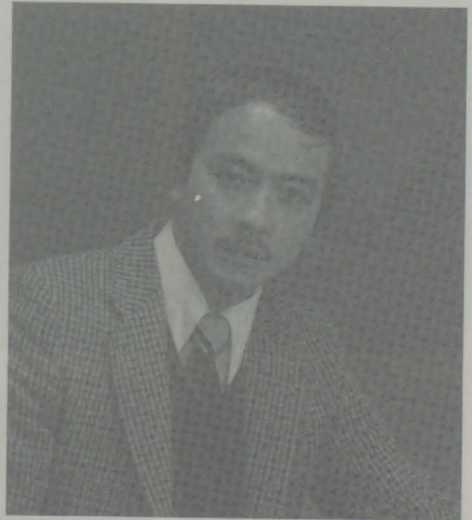

Dr. Van-Minh Huynh



The department of Mechanical Engineering lost one of its most valued professors with the sudden death of Dr. Van-Minh Huynh. He was 49 years old and passed away at work on May 30, 1994. Dr. Huynh is survived by his wife, Dorothy, and his sons, Eric and Nevin.

Perhaps best known to the Mechanical Engineering students for his courses in dynamics, machine dynamics, stress analysis and machine design, Dr. Huynh was also very active in research and in teaching courses on automated inspection and automated machining at the graduate level. His research activities were mostly in the area of vision systems.



Seven M.A.Sc. students and two Ph.D. students completed their degree requirements under his supervision. Recently, he was supervising four M.A.Sc. students and one Ph.D. student. Dr. Huynh was very active in his research activities having authored or co-authored 15 papers in refereed journals and 15 papers in conferences. Dr. Huynh obtained his B.Eng. degree from McGill University in 1968, and his M.Eng. degree from McMaster University in 1970. After completing his Ph.D. at McMaster University in 1974, he worked briefly at the Institute of Technology, University of Manchester, U.K. After that he worked in industry for White Farm Equipment in Brantford, DOFASCO in Hamilton, and NCR in Waterloo before joining the Department of Mechanical Engineering at the University of Windsor in 1983. He was promoted to Associate Professor in 1986 and to Professor in 1992.



As a valuable contributor to the Department, the Faculty and the University, Dr. Huynh will be sorely missed.
