



What the Research Says...

OIn a 2015 survey of United States based instructional designers and instructors, 79.7% of respondents replied that a librarian was, "rarely or never present as part of the course design team..." but the authors recommended a librarian to be on the team for "richer learning experiences." (Lenert & Janes, 2015)




In-depth: Instruction

 - O Topic and keyword selection
 - O How to "read" a research article
 - OFinding and evaluating sources
 - OCitation style/citation management program help
 - O Course specific: "trailblazers" in chemistry literature, data and statistics for infographics, zip code level data project, DS Lab




