"Actors can happen even in the best of families," goes an old saying. We in the PC Theatre Program do help actors and other theatre professionals to "happen." However, we see our purpose as much broader. The PC Theatre Arts Program is dedicated to bringing theatre into the lives of the members of the PC community — through its courses, its own productions and guest productions. We see theatre as an important aspect of a liberal arts education and of a reflective life. Providence College has, in fact, been producing plays almost from its founding. Theatre arts, though, was initiated as an academic program only in 1969 and has been offering a major only since 1971. We are proud of the young men and women who have been a part of our program — those who were majors, those who took a few courses and those who acted, built sets, sewed costumes and took tickets. Many of those PC theatre veterans have gone on to careers in theatre and we'd like to take this opportunity to brag about them.

NICHOLAS WALKER '77 now stars as Congressman Trey Clegg on the CBS daytime serial, "Capitol." While at PC Nicholas appeared in St. Joan, Rashomon, 1776, One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest and Godspell. Nicholas' classmate, PETER THOMSON completed an M.F.A. in acting at Wayne State University and for the past year has been a member of the repertory company at the Meadowbrook Theatre in Rochester, Michigan. Among the plays Peter has done at Meadowbrook is The Dining Room! As a PC student Peter had roles in Playboy of the Western World, Antigone and Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dream Coat, among others. Peter's wife, EILEEN BARRON THOMSON '81 received an M.F.A. in directing from Wayne State and has recently been hired as assistant producer at the Cherry Lane Theatre in New York. Besides acting at PC, Eileen stage managed and worked in the publicity office.

Other classmates working in theatre are DICK WARNER and JOHN GARRITY of the class of 73. Both received M.F.A.'s from Catholic University — Dick in acting and John in directing. Dick played Off-Broadway in **The Freak** and can be seen occasionally on the CBS daytime serial, "Guiding Light." Dick is presently doing **All My Sons** at the GeVa Theatre in Rochester, NY. He was also guest director for PC's production of **The Diary of Anne Frank** last year. Dick acted in several plays at PC, but is probably best remembered for Thomas More in **A Man For All Seasons**. John, of course, has been teaching theatre arts at PC since 1976 and has been director of the program since 1978. **The Dining Room** is the sixteenth play John has directed at PC. He is also a member of the Rhode Island

State Council on the Arts.

JOHN O'HURLEY '76 had roles in The Apple Tree, The Fantasticks, Butterflies Are Free, Death of A Salesman, The Birds and 1776 at PC. John toured nationally in Mass Appeal and now plays continued on page 6

Keith Lane on the ABC daytime serial, "Loving." Also working for ABC is DAN FOSTER '79 who appears as Alton on the daytime serial, "All My Children." Before going to New York Dan worked in PC's Alumni and Development Office. Dan acted in a variety of roles here and directed our productions of **Angel Street** and **Vanities.** JOE MENINO '78 played in the production of **Angel Street** which Dan directed as well as in **St. Joan** and **One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest.** Joe studied at the National Shakespeare Conservatory, toured with the National Shakespeare Company and has appeared at several

regional Shakespeare festivals.

Not all PC theater alumni are acting. Some, like Eileen Thomson and John Garrity, are working behind the scenes. CARL GUDENIUS '80 now works for the National Scenic Studios in Virginia which designs and builds scenery for plays, musicals and night club acts. Carl has an M.F.A. in scene design from Wayne State and for a while was instructor and scene designer at Indiana State University. Carl held a Blackfriars scholarship at PC and designed the sets for St. Joan, Candide, Playboy of the Western World and Two by Two. PAT WHITE '79 stage managed and worked in the costume shop as a student. Now she works in wardrobe and costuming in New York and in the summer is in charge of talent relations at the South Shore Music Circus in Cohasset, Mass. TRACY BALDINI '84, who house managed numerous PC productions, now works in the box office at the Shubert Theatre in New Haven.

Other PC theatre veterans are just getting started in their careers. DAVID BARBER '79 is working on an M.A. in drama criticism at New York University and was a Shubert Fellow last year. David did **Two by Two** and **Lysistrata**, among other plays, at PC. WALLY DUNN '82, who played in seven PC productions including **Dr. Jeckle and Mr. Hyde** and **She Stoops to Conquer**, is now pursuing an M.F.A. in acting at the University of Connecticut. PATTY CARVER '84, remembered for her singing in **Cabaret** and **Pippin**, appeared in **Grease** at the Zeiterion Theatre in New Bedford and recently had the lead in an Off-Broadway production of **Cabaret**. JOE HENDERSON, since graduation in '84, has played in **Man of La Mancha** at the Rhode Island College Summer Theatre and in **The Nutcracker** at the Zeiterion Theatre in New Bedford. Until recently he was teaching acting for Barbizon Models in Providence and has himself been doing free lance modeling.

Several PC grads are using their theatre experience, not in professional theatre, but in related areas. ANGELA DIAS '77 is now the news anchor person on WEAN Radio in Providence. At PC she appeared in 1776, Godspell, Rashomon and Night of the Iguana.
