Introduction to OpenCon Cleveland

- OpenCon Cleveland is a regional conference
- Launched as face-to-face event at Cleveland State University in 2018
- Successfully shifted to a virtual format in 2021
- The shift did not disrupt attendance

Year	Participants	Format
2019	70 attendees	Face-to-Face
2020	99 attendees	Face-to-Face
2021	Approximately 196 people	Virtual
2022	Approximately 141 people	Virtual

The OpenCon Cleveland P lanning Committee

- 2018-2021 institutional participation only
- 2022 broadened members with members from other institutions
- Diverse group (librarians, instructional designers, administrators, faculty) provides opportunities for:

Timeline:

OpenCon Cleveland 2020 – February 27th + February 28th held on campus

CSU campus announces 'temporary' closure on March 17th (many of us do not return to campus full time until July 2021).

OpenCon Cleveland 2021 – May 12th – 14th, Synchronous day May 14th

OpenCon Cleveland 2022 – May 16th – 20th, Synchronous day May 20th

Takeaway: The timing of our first virtual OpenCon Cleveland allowed us to consider our experience with other virtual conferences and events, and to take what we learned for OpenCon Cleveland 2022.

OpenCon Cleveland Virtual Model

Asynchronous (Slack)

- Prerecorded lightning talks presented in Slack
- Audience interaction with presenters and other attendees on Slack

Synchronous (Zoom)

- Panel sessions with lightning presenters and additional presenters
- Keynote presentations

Slack as a conference platform

- Slack is a message platform, built around #channels and discussion threads
- Slack allowed for asynchronous communication and served as structure for navigating the conference.
- #networking channels allowed for discussion outside of the conference presentations, and #social channels gave us a fun way to engage with attendees

Limitations and alternatives

- 'Virtual wayfinding' and scheduling in Slack
- Free tier of Slack limitations:
 - Archives up to 10,000 messages
 - Now only archives messages for 90 days
- Various other Slack equivalents exist, including some open-source options that could be supported by an institution's Information technology department
- Notably, Discord does not have the same message history limitations

- Inviting local participation in planning
 - Additional planning committee members

Accessibility

- Asynchronous Presentations
 - Captions

YouTube

2. YouTube will automatically create captions for your uploaded video. The captions can take several hours to appear. Once the captions are available on YouTube, you will need to make corrections to the automatically generated captions. To review and edit the captions for your video:

zoom

- · Go to studio.youtube.com and log in.
- Click on 'Content' in the left navigation bar.
- Find your video and click the Pencil icon (Details button).
- Click on 'Subtitles' in the left navigation bar.

• You will see an option for English (Automatic). Click on the 'Duplicate and Edit' button. Here you can edit the text of your subtitles. You can view the captions as a block of text, or you can click 'Assign Timings' to see subtitles with timestamps.

Click 'Save Draft' to save your edits. Click 'Publish' to publish the edited subtitles.
